### **Recent Updates**

*The days of the siege of the Yarmouk camp, that exceeded "420" days, did not intercede in the residents' crisis of water, where the water cut continues for the fourth day respectively, which increases their suffering, especially with power cut over a year ago. In addition to the prevention of the checkpoints of the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command of the entry of food and basic materials, all days of the siege except for a small amount barely covers the need for residents. It is mentioned that more than "154" refugees were killed because of the siege.*

*In a related context, the Department of Education of the UNRWA announced that, Sunday 14/09/2014 will be the first day of the start of the new academic year 2014/2015 for the alternative schools of the Yarmouk refugee camp, as it emphasized that UNRWA will continue to register students in educational centers accredited by the UNRWA, namely: "Al Aml alternative School " AL Taqadom neighborhood, " alternative Damascene school " AL Taqadom neighborhood – AL Thalathein street, " Al Azma alternative school " west of the camp, and " Jarmaq alternative school " schools Street.*

*On the other hand, many Palestinian families, which had fled earlier to Al Dokhaneia, Al Kbas and Dwylah areas east of the Syrian capital, Damascus, were displaced after the deterioration of the security situation after the entry of groups of the Syrian opposition to Al Dokhaneia area and after clashes that ended up with the control of those groups at the neighborhoods adjacent to those areas. According to a Palestinian refugee, that the situation of these families have become tragically where they sleep on the ground and live in public parks due to the lack of a place to live in, especially in light of the rising rents houses where residents demanded UNRWA, PLO and the Palestinian factions to shoulder their responsibilities towards them.*

*In Homs, the Syrian security forces arrested three Palestinian refugees, they are: "Mohammad Ali Al Rouba" 30 years, from Safad city in Palestine, he was arrested on 10.09.2014 when he went to work, on the pretext that he was born in Libya. The two young men, "Essam al-Khalidi," from Safad city in Palestine, and "Moaaz Omar Sbeiha" from Tarshaiha village in Palestine were arrested on 09.09.2014 from their workplace in the camp, and they are 40 years.*



*In Turkey, Chairman of the General Authority for Palestine Refugees in the Syrian temporary government "Ayman Abu Hashem", held a meeting with a number of young activists in Al Dar Foundation in the city of Istanbul, where he was in a meeting to discuss educational and developmental programs and the ways of joint cooperation. The meeting also touched the role of the Commission in support of institutions aimed at supporting the Palestinian Syrian refugees, especially children and young people, and in the end of the meeting the President of the Commission thanked and appreciated those in charge of Al Dar Foundation for their voluntary efforts in the service of humanitarian issues.*

*On the other hand, the Commission of Palestinians of Turkey, in the past two days, distributed cash aids to Palestinian families located in Rihaniyya, Adna, Antioch, Ottoman and Mersin, in order to alleviate the economic burden that they suffer as a result of high prices and a lack of steady income they have. It is worth to mention that the number of families in those areas and registered with the Commission reached 171 families.*
