"Two Palestinians Killed While They Fighting Alongside Syrian Regime In Aleppo"



- Alquds brigade pushes Palestinian fighters into Aleppo battles.
- Shelling targets the west side of Khan Esheih camp in Damascus suburbs.
- Two Palestinians were arrested in Homs camp.

VICTIMS

Two Palestinian victims were killed in the violent battles in Aleppo. The first fighter is Ammar Saleem Droubi, from Alquds brigade in Alneirb camp, announced dead during the clashes in Khnaser-Ethraya road in Aleppo suburbs.



Whereas, the second fighter, Mousa Ahmad Diab from Handarat camp, was killed during the clashes in Al-Zahra neighbourhood in Aleppo. It is indicated that Alquds brigade is a Palestinian militia fighting alongside Assad forces in Aleppo.





RECENT UPDATES

Alquds brigade, a militia supports Assad regime, recruited tens of Palestinian refugees in order to fight in different areas in Aleppo. The violent battles raging in north Syria entailed enlisting more fighters to support the front line, where Khanaser-Ethraya road in Aleppo suburbs.

According to AGPS correspondence, at least two victims killed in the recent few days. It is indicated that pro-Assad Palestinian groups impose a tight control to Al-Neirb camp supporting by Syrian forces.



In Damascus suburbs, the west side of Khan Esheih camp was subjected to shelling. A bomb was fallen to Alkhawaled neighbourhood opposite to Al-Huda mosque. The shelling has not resulted in any damages.

In the same context, residents of Khan Esheih camp appealed the two conflict parties for stopping the bombing. In addition, they call PLO, UNRWA, Palestinian embassy and factions to intervene in order to neutralising the camp and stop bombing civilian houses. Locals intensified that there are no justifications for the camp to be targeted, particularly, that all resident are civilians and no fighters in the camp at all.



In Homs, the Syrian security arrested two Palestinians, Mahmoud Farouk Meari in his forties arrested in 10/2, and Fahed Hayatleh in his late thirties arrested in 25/1 last month. The accident comes after the raid carried out by the security forces on "Infinity Mobile" shop in Alquds street.

It is indicated that Meari in origin is a descendant from Umqa village and Hayatleh from Alshajaraa in Palestine.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 13 February 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*

Palestine – General Command), continued for 973 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1035 days, water cut for 523 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.

- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 829 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1022 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 683 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
