Victims

Palestinian refugee Yahya Alwez, called Abu Hassan, from the ALSa'iqqa battalion in ALSayedat Zeinab Camp, died as he fought alongside the government forces in war-tattered Syria.



Latest Developments

Residents of Yarmouk and Daraa camps have launched cries for help over the acute water crisis, saying they have been forced to drink water spouting from contaminated artesian wells.

Speaking with AGPS, experts warned of the life-threatening diseases inflicted by the unhygienic artesian wells due to the germ-infested deposits accumulated in the absence of water-disinfection endeavors.

The Syrian government has cut off water supplies to Yarmouk Camp for over 947 days running and to Daraa Camp for over 1,096 consecutive days.



Meanwhile, AGPS documented the death of 1,140 Palestinian refugees, 855 among whom in bloody hostilities between the regime army and the opposition outfits. 461 refugees also died under torture in Syrian government jails.

Palestinians of Syria: April 13, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,478 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,183 Palestinian refugees, including 86 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,365 days in a row.*

- *195 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,096 and 947 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,440 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 174 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
