Recent Updates

The number of victims among the Palestinian refugees, who died due to the explosions of Alsayeda Zainab area in Damascus suburb, increased to 5 refugees, including a child. According to a social media page, the victims are:

The refugee, Mahmoud Hasan Tayem, Mohammed Abdulghafar Abu Alhaija, Taha Ahmed Sharqi, Mohammed Khalid Al Sawaf, and the child, Younes Awadallah Alnajar.



The explosion occurred on Saturday, 11-6-2016, at Al Sayeda Zainab area in Damascus suburb and resulted in the death of dozens of people and a lot of injuries. The area and its adjacent Palestinian camp are controlled by the Syrian security forces in cooperation with some affiliated Palestinian groups headed by the GC, Fatah Al Intifada, and Struggle Front.

The Palestinian refugee, Ibrahim Kamal AL Dahoodi, from Al Nairab camp, died during clashes that broke out in Aleppo suburb between ISIS and the Regular Army alongside the affiliated factions and Committees.



He was fighting alongside ISIS, and he was displaced from Ain Al Hilwa camp South of Lebanon at the beginning of events in Syria.

Meanwhile, the regular army stationed at Talat Al Kabouseya targeted the vicinity of Al Rahman mosque on Monday with an artillery shell causing panic among residents at the time of Iftar. The adjacent farms near Alsalam highway was also targeted by artillery shells from Al Kabouseia location.

The Syrian regime's warplanes dropped a number of explosive barrels at the western outskirts of Khan Al Shieh camp west of the capital Damascus, and the surrounding farms on Monday night and resulted in only material damages.

The military site of Talat Al Kabouseia is considered an obsession for residents of Khan Al Shieh camp because of the harm that they have suffered of the shelling by tanks and heavy artillery, which led to many deaths and injuries, as the AGPS documented the names of 151 victims of Palestinian refugees in Khan Al Shieh camp who died by aircrafts and artillery shelling.





Meanwhile, residents complain of the continuous shelling of Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road that links the camp with the adjacent areas, which was negatively reflected on their living conditions, and have created many crises such as medical and food supplies, in addition to the high prices due to the closure of the only road linking the camp with the capital Damascus

A number of activists and families of high school students, who left the Yarmouk camp, demanded people and parties responsible for the students to work seriously to ensure their returned after the end of the official exams in the capital, Damascus. The families expressed concern about their children, who are residing now at the Alliance Center, of being harmed while returning to the camp. They also called on sponsors of the students, such as the teaching staff and the Palestinian forces to ensure that they return safely after the end of exams.

The students, who came out of their besieged camps (Yarmouk south of Damascus-Khan Al Shieh camp in the western suburb of Damascus) to perform the high school exams, have complained of negligence and carelessness to their interim living status in the "Alliance" center of the capital Damascus, which is supervised by the refugee organization and UNRWA.

Activists and a number of students mentioned that they suffer of lack of food and water, as the students confirmed that the center is dirty and not cleaned on a daily basis .



Meanwhile, a student described the center as a prison and not inhabitable, as the students demanded to be provided with water and power on a daily bases around the clock, to improve the food, and to clean the center.

Dozens of Palestinian students, who came out of Khan Al Shieh camp to perform the high school exams of 2015 -2016 in the exam centers at Al Kiswa area then to the Alliance center, have returned to the camp despite the continued shelling, sniping, and clashes between the regular army the Syrian armed opposition groups.

It should be noted that a tank from the regiment 137 targeted a bus that was carrying a number of middle school students from Khan Al Shieh camp on 19/05/2016 while they were returning to the camp after the exams. Many buses were directly affected and break down on the edge of the road amid panic amongst he students. Members of the regiment 137 targeted the bus despite the bus was raising the United Nations flag and despite the coordination among the Refugees Foundation and UNRWA on the one hand and the seventh group of the regular army on the other hand.



A female student in the ninth grade was injured by shrapnel in the head, while returning to her home in Al Thanaweya Street, as she was



transferred immediately for treatment outside the camp, despite the difficult security situation and the targeting of civilians.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 13\06\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1094 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1155 days, water was cut for 644 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 948 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1139 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 800 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
