***“Rakan Hussein, Palestinian Syrian Refugee, Begins an Indefinite Hunger Strike Protesting Against the Delay of Reunion with his Children by Bulgarian Authorities on the Pretext of Non-Recognize Passports”***



Rakan Hussein

- Two Palestinians were killed under torture in the prisons of Syrian Security Forces.
- Bombing on Neirab camp in Aleppo, and vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city.
- Continuation of the blockade on the Yarmouk refugee camp for more than ten months.
- General Authority for Palestine Refugees, in the Syrian temporary government, distributes aid to the Palestinian refugees in Ferran Shaheir Turkish camp.

### **Hungary**

*"Rakan Hussein", Palestinian Syrian refugee, Began an open hunger strike, protesting against the obstacles, set by the Hungarian government, about the procedures of reunion with his five children. "Rakan Hussein" expressed, to our correspondent, his suffering, saying, "I had, like hundreds of Palestinian refugees in Syria, to migrate to Europe because of what Syria suffers of war and destruction, lost my wife and my mother during the explosive barrels bombardment on Muzeireeb town in Daraa. Adding that "after a tough journey I reached Hungary to request asylum, and I already got a permanent residence there, and when I began the reunion procedures, I faced many problems, The first is preventing the entry of my five children, by Lebanon and Jordan, to make interview with the Hungarian embassy, forcing them to gamble their lives by land travelling in order to reach the Turkish crossing border illegally. Turkey also prevent the entry of Palestinian Syrian refugees, "he adds, "Upon the arrival of my children to Turkish to make the interview with the Hungarian embassy, the embassy conditioned that their entry into Turkey has to be legal and they did not recognize the "Syrian passports" as stipulated by the Hungarian authorities to get another passport for children, and this is very difficult, even passports of the Palestinian Authority take several months.*





*Rakan said, "when I went to the Palestinian embassy in Hungarian I was treated in a very bad way, and a sense of upstage and arrogance, I was not given any solutions. After this suffering, I decided to start hunger strike here from the camp near Budapest, in a protest against the obstacles that faces Syrian Palestinians, and I demand the Hungarian authorities to recognize the Palestinian passports and allow my children, who are in Turkey, to catch up with me, is it not enough that they have lost their mother and grandmother!, do they want them to lose their father as well??!!"*

### **Victims**

*Lawrence Shafei and Hammam Shafie, from Husseiniya camp in Damascus city, were killed under torture in prisons of Syrian security Forces.*

### **Recent Updates in Syria**

*Violent explosions sounds were heard in Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city resulted in missiles and explosive barrels bombardment on the areas adjacent to the camp. In the south of Syria, Nihad Ibrahim and Iyad Ibrahim were injured due to a shooting near Itman town in Muzeireeb camp.*

*Siege still imposed on Yarmouk camp by the Regular Army Forces and groups of the Popular Front - General Command for more than ten months, while bursts of bullets were heard in Khan \_ Dannoun camp at Damascus city, turned out to be fired from camp barrier. Khan Dannoun refugee camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from the camps because of the bombing and siege.*
