“Explosive Barrels Bombings Targeting Khan Al Shaih Vicinity and Targeting a Car on Zakia Road”



Khan Al Shaih camp

- The Syrian Army prevents the residents of Al Husainiya and Sbeina camps to return back to their houses.
- The Yarmouk camp is without water since five days, water crises in Al Muzareeb compound.
- Distribution of a limited quantity of aids to the Yarmouk residents.
- A boat that carries Palestinian refugees from Egypt arrived Europe in addition to a boat that sank in front of the Maltese coast.

Recent Updates

The Surrounding areas of Khan Al Shaih camp in Damascus city were exposed to bombing with explosive barrels, where the warplanes targeted the surrounding areas with four explosive barrels in addition to the target of a resident car while he was driving on the Zakia road which led to explosions and a number of injured people. In terms of living, the residents complain of the continuation of the cut of roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas which has a negative reflection on the availability of basic materials.

The residents of Al Husaineyya and Al Sbeina camps are still prevented to return back to their houses by the checkpoints of the Regular army and some Palestinian factions loyal to the Army. The residents were prevented to return back to their houses without clear causes, where the two camps are completely controlled by the Syrian Army after heavy clashes between the Army and the free army and ended with the complete control of the Syrian Army on Al Husaineyya camp in October 2013 and on Al Sbeina camp in November 2013. It is mentioned that the residents were distributed on the surrounding areas and towns which adds more economic burdens on the residents especially the high costs of rent houses and the spread of unemployment.



In Damascus, the Yarmouk residents are still suffering from the water cut for the fifth day respectively which increased the residents' suffering that are besieged since 421 days. The Checkpoints of the Syrian Army and the PFGC prevent the entry of food materials and fuel to the camp in addition to the power cut for more than a year which caused the stop of all hospitals and clinics of the camp except the Palestine hospital which provides limited services because of the shortage of the staff and materials. In a related context, limited quantities of food aids were distributed yesterday on the Yarmouk residents who were waiting for their turn since the early morning.

In Dara'a, the Muzareeb compound residents suffer of complete water cut which forced the residents to buy water in high prices where the tank's price is 12 USD which increases the residents' economic burdens who lost their work and the source of income. It is mentioned that the compound receives hundreds of families who were displaced from Dara'a camp to the surrounding areas due to the Dara'a frequent bombing.

In Italy, one of the local radios said news about a boat that sank in front of the Maltese coast and it is expected that the boat was launched from Libya. The searching operations are still going on. The Action Group received news about that the Egyptian coast guards arrested about 150 Palestinian and Syrian refugees in the Egyptian regional water while they were heading to Italy.

The Jenin Sports Club concluded yesterday in the Yarmouk camp its summer sports activity under the title of "Ashbal Al Quds" in order to develop the skills of the camp's children and for entertainment to alleviate their suffering due to the ongoing war in Syria and the continuation of the Yarmouk siege for 420 days respectively. It is worth to mention that the ceremony was ended by certificates distribution on the participants of Ashba Al Quds course and a number of commissions and institutions which contributed to the course.
