"179 Victims from the Residents of Khan Al Sheih Camp since the beginning of the ongoing War in Syria"



- Targeting the only Road in Khan Al Sheih camp with Artillery Shells

Recent Updates

AGPS Monitoring and Documentation team declared that the number of victims from Khan Al Sheih camp since the beginning of the conflict in Syria reached 179 victims, including 89 due to bombing, 29 bullets shooting, 25 due to torture, 4 refugees sniping, 1 execution, 12 kidnapping and then killed, 6 drawn in the sea, 4 due to a bomb car, 6 due to Israeli Occupation Shooting and a refugee died due to unknown reasons and the last one died due to suffocation.



It is worthy to mention that the number of the Palestinian refugees who died since the beginning war in Syria reached 3312 victims, according to AGPS documented statistics.

The Syrian Regime targeted Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road and Al Abaseyya area with 7 artillery shells, the Regime also targeted Al Mansour Oven with Fuzdika Shells, according to activists the targeting was by the Regime Forces centered in Al Kabousa hill. All this comes amid increased suffering that the residents of the camp live in due to the Regular Army checkpoints which prevents the access of civilians and goods cars that led to increasing their life crisis specially the medical services.



Al Aedin camp residents in Homs complain of the deteriorated health situation and not benefiting from the free health services of UNRWA after losing the only UNRWA clinic in the camp. Dr. Asem Al Shehaby, one of the camp's residents, said that the clinic is closed since 4 months and unofficially closed since 6 years under the pretext of appointing assigning for the clinic.

Dr. Al Shehaby insured that the doctors' special clinics turned to be charity clinics and the free UNRWA clinic in considered from the biggest clinics and demanded to open the clinic and forming a group of five doctors to work on a daily basis in addition to providing services to people for free.



The Committee of Following up Homs Caps Affairs sent earlier a letter to the Director of UNRWA Affairs in Syria, Michael Kingsley, about the needs of the Palestinian refugees in Al Aedin camp in Homs, the letter emphasized the daily life of the Palestinian refugee and included the relief, education, health, hygiene and the careers.

In Aleppo, the Palestinian refugee Ahmed Saleem Rae' from Al Nairab camp was injured due to participation in fighting with Al Quds Brigade



in Al Ramousa area battles which is near Al Nairab camp, where the violent clashes, explosions and warplanes bombing were heard clearly from the camp and black smoke didn't disappear from the sky.

Al Nairab camp witnesses a state of instability and insecurity due to the tension of the security situation in the neighboring areas, where the location of the camp is near Al Nairab military airport which makes the camp as a strategic location for the conflict parts in Syria, and it was earlier exposed to bombing and fire shooting that led to victims among the civilians.

Within the Urgent Relief project, the Charity Organization for the Relief of the Palestinian People distributed about 100 food parcels to the Palestinian families registered in its records and live in Rokn Al Dein area in Damascus. It is mentioned that the Charity Organization launched a number of relief projects in Syria as to alleviate the suffering of the Palestinian refugees and the economic burdens that resulted in their displacement from their camps and compounds due to the ongoing conflict in Syria.





Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 14\08\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid 2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1153 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1214 days, water was cut for 703 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1006 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 197 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 857 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
