“Al Yarmouk, AL Nairab and Daraa Camps, three Palestinian Camps in Syria without Water”



- **Two Palestinians were killed in Syria, one of them due to an explosive bomb in his car.**
- **Heavy clashes in the vicinity of Handarat Camp in Aleppo.**
- **About 300 Palestinian and Syrian refugees appeal the International Organization to intervene to put an end to their suffering.**
- **One of the residents of AL Aedein camp was arrested while he was receiving treatment in Bisan Hospital.**
- **Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon visits the head of the UNRWA Office in Biqaa city in Lebanon.**

Victims

The Palestinian refugee Mahmoud Hjair was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons after being detained for more than seven months , and Ghasan Mahmoud AL Saadi from Rokn Al Dein area in Damascus due to an explosive bomb in his car. It is mentioned that AL Saadi is a member that loyal to the Regular Army.



Recent Updates

The water crises is still exacerbating in the Palestinian Camps in Syria in more than one city, where Daraa Camp is suffering of the water cut for about 183 days, while in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus the water cut for 36 days respectively. In Al Nairab camp in Aleppo the water since yesterday. As the water cut complicate the living situation, especially in the Yarmouk Camp which is besieged for about 468 days, and Daraa camp which is a huge parts of it were destroyed due to the repeated bombing during the last year.

In another hand, heavy clashes broke out in the vicinity of Handarat Camp in Aleppo between groups affiliated To the Syrian Opposition and the Regular Army; the clashes resulted in a number of victims in the two parties.

The clashes coincided with heavy and intense bombing through warplanes, artillery, and Gvozdika on Handarat and the areas that



controlled by the Syrian opposition .Meanwhile, Handarat camp and the adjacent areas witnessed confrontations and violent military operations, at a time of continuing casualties every day, as the Action Group documented the numbers of the victims in Handarat camp since the start of the crisis in March 2011 by about 34 people.

About 300 Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees in Macadamia appeals the international and the human rights organizations to intervene to help them find a solution to their problem and allowing them to migrate to the European countries. They also demanded to improve their living conditions inside Camp "Ghazi Baba", where a refugee described their humanitarian conditions are miserable as a result of the lack of accommodation for all refugees, and added that many of them sat on the ground what they have suffered a state of frustration and depression.

Going back to Syria, the Syrian security forces arrested of young man, "Salim Mahmoud Bahloul" on 12.10.2014, from Bisan hospital in Al Aedein Camp in Homs while he was receiving treatment there, it is mentioned that he is 20 years, from Haifa city in Palestine.

As in Lebanon, a delegation of the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and the Follow-up Committee for Displaced People in the Bekaa has organized last Monday a visit to the Director of the Office of UNRWA " Ahmed Mawwah " in Taalbaya.



The visit to the Director of the UNRWA Office



The purpose of the visit was to inform him on the living conditions and the difficult conditions experienced by the Palestine refugees displaced from Syria to Lebanon due to the recent decision by UNRWA about cut off financial aid to 1100 Palestinian families in Syria, the delegation also discussed many topics and problems suffered by the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon, the delegation stressed the need to bear the full responsibility of UNRWA towards them .

The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 468 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 549 days and the water cut for 36 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 368 days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 338 days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:***-The residents left the camp since 537 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:***-The continuance of raising the tension pace and bombing the adjacent areas with explosive barrels.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - A tension state still prevailed amongst its residents due to the bombing by the Opposition Forces.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - Almost 183 days without water and a complete absence of basic services in addition to the displacement of hundreds of its people due to the siege, frequent bombing, and clashes .
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - the power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
