“Typhoid Epidemic Spread in the Yarmouk Refugee Camp, a Campaign of Inspection Raids Launched by the Syrian security in Al Aedein Camp at Homs”



Al Aedein Camp

- A Palestinian was killed in Syria.
- Khan AL Sheih camp in the fire circle and the bloody overheating conflict in Syria.
- Continuation of the introducing of food parcels to the Yarmouk refugee camp.

Victims

Mohammed Ben Saleh Hamash from Handarat camp in Aleppo died as a result of injuries due to clashes that broke out in the vicinity of the camp between Free Army groups and regular Army.

In the same context, Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of the Palestinian Syrian refugee victims in Handarat camp, who were killed because of the ongoing events in Syria, has reached 33 victims until the end of May2014.

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling with explosive barrels targeted Khan AL Sheih camp, which is located 40km southwest Damascus. Warplanes launched two explosive barrels targeted the west vicinity of the camp coincided with the bombing of adjacent areas and farms.

The residents of Khan Al Sheih camp, which is considered the second biggest camp in Syria, suffer of the escalation of military confrontations between groups of FSA and the Regular Army in the surrounding areas.

These confrontations put the camp In the fire circle and the bloody overheating conflict in Syria, as it has a negative impact on the people,



who suffer from a serious humanitarian crisis as a result of the increasing of shortage in basic foodstuffs, and the continued power and communication outages for long periods.

In the meantime, UNRWA has distributed a limited amount of food aid to the people of Yarmouk camp, who are under a suffocating siege imposed by the Regular Army at the entrances and exits of the camp for the day 363 respectively.

The residents suffer from the continuing power full cut from the camp a few months ago, when people were forced to rely on private generators, which in turn depend on the fuel that is not available.

In terms of medical conditions, the Yarmouk residents complain of a severe shortage of medicines, supplies and medical staff and the spread of many chronic diseases, which led to the death of many victims. In the same context, medical staff in the Yarmouk refugee camp raised alarm after announcing that the medical bodies operating in the camp receive daily between 10 to 15 cases infected with typhoid fever and anemia. The doctors warned from the spread of many chronic and communicable diseases as tuberculosis disease, among the people of the camp, if the situation continues as it is.



On the other hand, the Syrian security forces launched a campaign of inspection raids in Al Aedein camp in Homs, where its members broke into some closed shops and inspected thoroughly, as they searched the cars and asked for the identity cards of passers. This campaign caused a state of panic among the residents, who suffer of the spread of unemployment in addition to the high cost of living and rising prices of foodstuffs.

Meanwhile, the rest of the residents of Dara'a Camp southern Syria, suffer of full water cut on all parts of the camp for the 11th day respectively, which forced its residents to walk long distances to have drinking water, putting their lives at risk because of the spread of snipers above the buildings overlooking the streets of the camp.

Under the slogan "cry of anger for Gaza", hundreds of people came out of Alnairab camp northern Syria, in a solidarity march with the people of the Gaza Strip, condemning the brutal Zionist aggression on the Gaza Strip, which has killed hundreds of innocent civilian.

A similar solidarity march came out of Al Raml camp in Latakia to support Gaza and Palestinian resistance as well as to condemn the continuous Zionist aggression.

Solidarity Marches
