### **Recent Updates**

*According to reports received from the besieged Yarmouk camp, the Palestinian young man, "Malik Usman" died today by sniper shot in the camp. The young man, "Mohammed Diab" was shot in the hand in Al Orouba area southeast of the camp by a sniper as he was sent to Al Maydani hospital to receive treatment. An 8-year-girl was also injured by a sniper in Abu Hashish Square center of the camp .*



*This comes amid tension field conditions in the camp, after violent clashes broke out between the Al Nusra Front and ISIS in Yarmouk nine days ago. The clashes have exacerbated the living and health conditions significantly, while the two parties burn civilian homes.*

*Spokesman of UNRWA, Chris Gunness, expressed concern about the humanitarian consequences of the violent armed conflict between the extremist armed groups inside the Yarmouk since the sixth of April.*

*Gunness said in remarks published by the media department of the United Nations: "It is painful to see another chapter of high tension and suffering imposed on civilians in the Yarmouk camp".*

*He explained that "the ongoing fierce fighting not only results in casualties and deaths among civilians, but it also sharply exacerbates the*



*shortages of food and drinking water for about 6000 families within the Yarmouk".*



*Meanwhile, "UNRWA" called the concerned parties to cease hostilities and comply with their obligations under international humanitarian law to respect and protect the lives of civilians in the Yarmouk camp .*

*In Aleppo, violent clashes are still continuous in the vicinity of Handarat camp between the Syrian armed opposition groups on the one hand and the forces of the regular army alongside "al-Quds Brigade" on the other hand, where the latter is seeking to impose its control over the camp.*

*On the other hand, Palestinian militants accused al-Quds Brigade of recruiting a group of young Palestinian refugees from Al Nairab and Handarat camps, and send them to the battlefield under the pretext of liberating Handarat camp and protecting the Palestinian camps. Many victims died during these battles, where the Palestinian youth, "Ahmed Abou Khashaba," who did not finish his 16th years, died a few days ago during Handarat camp battles. The armed opposition groups broadcasted*





*a videotape of what it claimed victims from a group loyal to the regime who were killed in the camp battles.*

*The camp is completely empty, where residents were forced to leave due to violent clashes that broke out between the regime and opposition forces, before about 1076 days. The clashes ended with the opposition control over camp, which in turn prevents people from returning to the camp since that period. The Syrian regime targeted the camp frequently by explosive barrels throughout that period, which resulted in the destruction of approximately 80% of the camp's houses.*

*On the other hand, Italian activists confirmed that the Italian Coast Guard rescued hundreds of illegal immigrants over the past few days. The immigrants launched from the Egyptian and Libyan shores.*

*The boats from Egypt and Libya, called "boats of death" due to the severity of such boats and the large number of accidents that claimed the lives of hundreds of people in the Mediterranean.*





*The re-use of Egyptian beaches as a springboard for "boats of death" after Turkey tightened its procedures in place to prevent the boats from launching from its territory towards Greece, after the agreement had been signed with the European Union, the beginning of March provides clauses on anti-immigration illegal.*

***Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 15\04\2016:***

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1035 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1095 days, water was cut for 585 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 890 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1083 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 743 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
