Victims

Palestinian refugee Basel Khalil AlMesri was pronounced dead in the bloody clashes between the Syrian government forces and the opposition outfits near the Air Force Intelligence facility, east of Daraa Camp.

At least 377 Palestinians sheltered in Daraa province were killed since the outburst of the Syrian warfare.



Latest Developments

The Syrian government forces have stepped up onslaughts on Daraa Camp and its surrounding villages using internationally prohibited weapons.

Reporting from the scene, dozens of surface-to-surface missiles slammed into Daraa Camp and AlSadd Road, housing Palestinian families.

Speaking with AGPS, activists said the Syrian regime army continues to strike Daraa Camp with barrel bombs carrying the internationally-banned incendiary napalm substance.



In Live snapshots taken from the area civilian homes and facilities appear to be burned to a crisp due to the simmering blitzkriegs on the camp.

A few days earlier, Free Daraa Council declared Daraa city, Daraa Camp, and AlSadd Road “disaster zones.”



Over recent weeks, the Syrian government battalions have targeted Daraa Camp and the surrounding towns with barrel bombs, surface-to-surface missiles, and napalm grenades in an attempt to grab hold of the area.

Meanwhile, Palestinian refugees from Syria in Turkey slammed the Palestinian Embassy for complicating aid-distribution procedures after the embassy ruled that identity documents must be shown to receive aids.

Dozens of families have been shorn of cash aids after they failed to show identity documents.

Hundreds of Palestinian families from Syria fled their homes for fear of being killed in the rampant hostilities, leaving their personal documents



at home. Others have lost their documents on the migration road. Their appeals to the Syrian authorities to hand them copies of their identity papers have frequently gone unheeded.

Some 8,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria have been enduring abject conditions in the Turkish territories due to the high rates of poverty and unemployment, along with the absence of relief assistance.

Civil Action Committees

The Palestinian Charity Commission, in partnership with Islamic Relief Worldwide, distributed 150 food baskets to a number of Palestinian families from Syria in Wadi AlZeina, in the southern Lebanese area of AlKharoub.

The move makes part of underway endeavors to assuage the crises endured by the Palestinian refugee community from Syria in Lebanon.

Some 450 Palestinian families from Syria have been taking cover in Wadi AlZeina.





Palestinians of Syria: June 15, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,520 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,608 Palestinian refugees, including 100 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,424 days in a row.*
- *196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,159 and 1,010 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,503 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 237 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
