Recent Updates

In the begging of the solidarity week with the Palestinians of Syria, the Palestine League and the Palestinian Women League in Germany carried out a seminar titled "Palestinians of Syria... Nakba renews Nakba" , which was delivered by Mr. Tareq Hamoud , the Executive Manager of the Palestinian Return Center in London, at Dortmund city, Germany.

Mr. Tareq Hamoud presented a detailed presentation for the suffering of the Palestinians of Syria refugees during the ongoing war in Syria such as bombing, siege, clashes and displacement. He also presented the difficult living conditions that the refugees suffer of inside the camps in Syria and out of Syria in the neighboring countries, he also shed the light on the strict siege that is imposed on the Yarmouk camp for the Palestinian Refugees in Damascus since 589 days and led to 165 refugee victims who died due to the malnutrition and the lack of medical care.

Mr. Tareq Hamoud continued to talk about the cruel situation that the Palestinian Refugees suffer in the Syria neighboring areas, he also mentioned that most of those countries prevent completely the entry of the Palestinian Syrian to its territories, which prompted thousands of them to risk their lives and their children's lives riding the so called "Death Boats" in order to reach the European countries asking for safety and decent life. Mr. Tareq Hamoud referred to that dozens of Palestinians of Syria refugees are detained in Egypt and Thailand in addition to hundreds of refugees who are stuck in Cyprus and Greece, and he also mentioned that the detainees in Egypt are still on a hunger strike since about a week.



It is mentioned that the seminar comes within a group of seminars that were held in Berlin-Germany, Rotterdam- Netherlands and Malmo-Sweden. Those activities were according to a series of activities that were



prepared by the Palestinians of Europe Conference No.13 in coordination with a number of Palestinian organizations in the European countries for solidarity with the Palestinians of Syria and to demand to take the siege of the Yarmouk Camp away.

The AGPS documentation team declared earlier that the number of the Palestinians of Syria victims till 14/2/2015 reached 2648 Palestinians of Syria victims. On the other hand, the officer of the relief file in the National Commission Mr. Mohammed Taha "Abu Amjad" was exposed to a failure assassination operation by unknown groups in front of his house in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian Refugees in Damascus. It is mentioned that this is the second time to target Mr. Mohammed Taha during the last two days. The assassination of Mr. Mohammed Taha came after the assassination of the Member of the Civil Council Mr. Nemer Husine due to a bullet he attained while getting out of his house at Al Rija Square in The Yarmouk Camp.

It is mentioned that the Palestinian National Commission was established in December 2012 to work for a camp that is free of weapons to neutralize the camp from the consequences of the ongoing war in Syria. Mr. Foad Omar was the head of the commission but he was arrested by the PFGC checkpoint then he was handled to the Syrian Security to die due to torture in the Syrian Security prisons.

It is mentioned that the AGPS insured in a report that was previously published that the second half of 2014 witnessed a growth in the assassination phenomena, which targeted the activists inside the Yarmouk camp. Mr. Baha Saqer , a member of the Yarmouk Residents



league, was assassinated in the camp, the Activists Ahmed Al Sahli” Abu Adel and Abdullah Bader” Abu Odi” were also assassinated . Ali Al Hajja was assassinated in Al Orouba Street then Mohammed Yusidf Areesha “ Abu Al Abed”, the head of the Relief Office in the Camp, was assassinated and after Abu Al Abed Areesha assassination unknown people assassinated Mohammed Teraweyya the representative of Fateh Movement in the Yarmouk Camp.

In terms of living, the continuation to prevent the entry of aids to the Besieged Palestinian Refugees led to a raise in the prices of food materials that some merchants monopolize ,where the price of the Rice KG and Sugar KG reached 10\$ and the Bread Pack reached 8\$.

On the other side, the volunteers of Al Yarmouk Secondary School organized a protest sit-in demanding the International organizations the commissions and the institutions that work outside the camp to support the camp to continue with the teaching process.it is mentioned that in the beginning of the crises, the camp depended on the curriculum strengthening lessons for the secondary school students in a basement fearing from the shells, the classes contained at that time about 40 female and male students arts section and 35 Female and Male students science section, then, there was no place for the 10th and 11th grades.

With the passing of time, they changed their place to Abdelqader Elementary School where it contained new classes and the number of 10th grade students reached 17 males and 35 females. Moreover, the number of secondary school arts section students reached 25 males and



30 females, the science section reached 25 males and 15 females. The unavailability of enough books, teachers' salaries and stationeries are from the most prominent problems in the camp.

In terms of the water crises inside the Yarmouk Camp, the crises continues since 159 days ,where the Palestine Red Crescent Society in the Yrmouk camp carried out yesterday a disinfection campaign included the a number of the camp's water tanks inside the camp to decrease the pace of the water pollution. It is mentioned that the relief organizations and the residents get their water from the artesian water well and it has to be disinfected.

In Damascus Suburb, the Syrian security and the Regular Army targeted the road that connects Khan Al Shieh and Zakia area with a number of bursts of heavy weapon, from the forces number 137, coincided with artillery raids that also targeted the same place. Despite the danger of the road but the residents didn't find any other road due to the closure of all roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas.

In a related context, the Palestine Charity Commission distributed some relief aids to the residents of the camp. It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinian families fled from their camps to Khan Al Shieh camp due to bombing, siege and clashes that targeted their camps.

In Lebanon, the Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian People ended its relief project" Ruhama Binahum" by distributing 400 food baskets for the last and third day of the project. The project beneficiaries' number is about 1090 families from the Palestinian Camps in Beirut.





Numbers and Statistics till 15/2/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2649 Palestinian refugee victims were documented by the AGPS.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 589 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 669 days, water was cut for 159 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 165 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 491 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 460 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 662 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 306 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
