Victims

Rapid escalation of torture victims' number of the Palestinian detained refugees in the Syrian regime's prisons who have been identified through the leaked pictures a few days ago; the identified bodies are:

- *The young man "Yaser Esam Al Naji," was born in 1985 from the besieged Yarmouk camp and lives at the the entrance of Al Forn Al Ihteyati.*
- *The young man "Osama Hussein Salim" (Aldamouni), from the Yarmouk camp, he was arrested on 24.02.2012 at the Yarmouk camp checkpoint by the General Command groups, and he was handed over to the Syrian security services to diedue to torture.*
- *The young man "Omar Mahahi" from the Yarmouk refugee camp, died under torture and his body was identified among the leaked images.*
- *The refugee "Ala Al Naji" from Damar neighborhood and he died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime on 08/07/2014.*
- *The refugee "Omar Khalid Nayef" from Khan Al Shieh camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb.*
- *"Mohammed Rakad," from Damar neighborhood, and he worked as a bus driver.*
- *"Samer Yousef Hassan," from Damar neighborhood.*
- *"Tayseir Sakhnini," a Palestinian refugee from Damar neighborhood.*

Meanwhile, the following bodies were earlier identified:

- *"Mohammed al-Khatib," "Tariq Mawed", "Mohamed Khaled Abu Eid", "Mahmoud Mohamed Mawed", "Ibrahim Mohammed Amer", "Abdul Latif Saed", "Suleiman al-Abdullah," "Noor Said ", " Islam Ammar Abu Rashid, " and " Hassan Hassan. "*

Moreover, the two young women, "Huda Jaber Hamdan" 19-year-old from the city of Qudsaya, and "Bisan Abdul Ghani," 22-year-old was arrested three years ago, a resident of Al Tadamoun neighborhood, as she died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS announced earlier that the victims of torture of Palestinian Syrian refugees who were documented has reached (315) victims.

Recent Updates

The family of the child "Omar Al Taweil" and activists in the Yarmouk refugee camp appealed to allow the exit of the child "Omar" from the camp to receive treatment in the hospitals of the capital Damascus. The appeal came as a result of the weakness of potentials, medicines, and specialist staff inside the besieged camp. The 11-month-child is suffering from Sick cell anemia and spleen hypertrophy, as the medical staff in Palestine Hospital is unable to transfer blood units for him in order to avoid additional damage to the spleen that may cause his death.

It is noteworthy that Palestine Hospital is the only hospital that covers the needs of more than 20,000 besieged people on the medical level, despite the simple and modest potentials, because the Syrian army and the General Command continued to siege the Yarmouk camp for (617) days respectively, power cut for more than (697) days, and water for 187 days respectively.

In a related issue, amount of aid was distributed yesterday to the besieged people of the camp, coincided with the entry of a PLO delegation to the camp to discuss the neutralization agreement.

On the other hand, a number of shells targeted Al Teiba town adjacent to Khan Dannon camp where a number of the Syrian opposition armed groups exist, as the explosions were heard clearly inside the camp, provoking a state of tension among the residents. The residents also complain from the high cost of living and high prices in addition to the high cost of rent houses inside the camp due to the huge displacement to the camp by the residents of the other camps who were obliged to leave their houses because of the bombing and siege which forced many families to rent one house for more than one family in order to pay the costs. The residents also suffer of the shortage of the basic services where the camp already suffers from the lack of public services such as health, medicine and transportations. The unemployment was spread amongst the residents due to the security tension in its vicinity which made the aids of the relief organizations as the only source for securing their basic needs.



In a different context, Al Nairab camp residents who are in Europe called for an explanation from Al Quds Brigade, which is affiliated to the Syrian Regime, for that one of their leader published on his personal page that they grabbed some of expatriates houses inside the camp. It is mentioned that the residents of Al Nairab camp immigrated to Europe and the neighboring countries due to the bad security and economic situation and the continuation of the ongoing war in Syria and its negative impacts on the reality of the Palestinian refugees such as killing, detention and destroying houses.

Civil Work Committees

Al Wafaa European champagne announced the beginning of the rapid relief project in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees where it is decided to start the project on stages and it will include food parcels distribution in order to alleviate the suffering of the residents.

In the same context, Jafra organization for Relief and Development in the Yarmouk camp continues to provide its services to the besieged people inside the camp where it cleans the streets of the camp including cleaning the rebels of the bombing and the garbage from the streets of the camp in order to stop the spread of diseases inside the besieged camp.

Numbers and Statistics till 15/3/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - *Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 617 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 697 days, water was cut for 187 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 172 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 519 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 488 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - *Residents have left the camp for 690 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - *It is now almost 334 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - *A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - *Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
