“Explosive Barrels Target Dara'a Camp, Resulted in at Least 6 Victims and Dozens of Wounded”



Victims of the bombing which targeted Daraa camp with explosive barrels

- After being besieged for a year, an old man died in the Yarmouk camp because of the lack of medical care.
- A Palestinian girl died in a Jordanian hospital affected with her wounds.
- 936 Palestinian refugees died in the Yarmouk camp until the end of Jun 2014.
- The stop of all bakeries, clinics and hospitals, still continues in the Yarmouk camp.
- Distribution of aid in the Yarmouk camp, and the exit of some medical cases.
- The residents of Al Aedien camp in Hama in solidarity with the people of Gaza.
- Water crises in Khan Dannon and Yarmouk camps.
- Humanitarian aid for the children of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo.
- A state of calm prevailed in Khan AL Sheih camp in Damascus city.

Victims

Six victims until now were died due to the bombing of Dara'a camp, they are:

Amani Mohammed Imara, Mohammed Saad Imara, Kholoud Mahmoud Bardan, Manaf Abdul Naser Al Masri, the child Marah Waseim Mteir and the child Hamza Waseim Mteir.

Meanwhile, the Palestinian child Maria Abdu Al Sneidi was died at Al Ramtha hospital in Jordan due to wounds she attained because of the bombing of AL Muzaireib in Dara'a camp a week before.

Recent Updates

An explosive barrel targeted Dara'a camp southern Syria by Syrian warplanes which resulted in 6 victims, at least, and dozens of wounded. Meanwhile they still search for survivors amongst the rubble of homes, where bombing caused a complete destruction of a lot of homes with its residents inside, as the people face big difficulties in succor the wounded and pick the injuries because of the severe lack of medical materials and equipments.

On the other hand, the strict siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp by Regular Army and groups of Public Front-General Command has entered the first year. The Regular Army checkpoints prevent the entry of fuel and basic supplies in addition to the prevention of entering people as well, with exception of some international and relief organizations to enter a limited amount of aid to the besieged people.

The siege led to an aggravation of health and relief crises inside the camp, as all bakeries stopped working because of the running out of flour and fuel in addition to the power outage.

All hospitals and clinics stopped working as well after the running out of medical supplies and the displacement of all medical staff because of the



siege and repeated bombing of the camp which led to a severe harms of health facilities.

With the entry of the first year of blockade, the documentary team of Action Group for Palestinians of Syria confirmed that 936 Palestinian refugees have died in the Yarmouk refugee camp, including 152 refugees died as a result of the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the blockade.

The camp also suffers of power outages for more than a year, in addition to the water crisis, which has worsened in recent months, prompting some relief institutions inside the camp to provide the residents with water by tanks that are not enough for all people. In a related context, a limited amount of aid was distributed yesterday to the people of the camp, in addition to the exit of some critical cases in order to receive treatment in hospitals outside the camp.

On the other hand, each of Syrian and Palestinian Red Crescent and UNICEF organizations have distributed some food aid to the children of Alnairab camp in Aleppo, who did not exceed five years.

It is worth mentioning that the camp, which is under the control of the Regular Army and some Palestinian groups loyal to it, suffer of hard living conditions in addition to being subjected to repeated bombardment



during the past few days. The camp is located in an important position and considered to be the gate for each of Alnairab civil and military airports.

Meanwhile, water crises in Kahn Dannoun at Damascus city, is still continuous, where people have to buy water from tankers which increase the economic burdens. The camp receives hundreds of families who were displaced from their camps because of the bombing and siege, as the residents suffer of the spread of unemployment and the high cost of living.

A state of calm prevailed throughout Khan AL Sheih camp in Damascus city under the continued outage of landline telecommunication and internet for about 17 days. Therefore, the camp suffer of a severe shortage in medical services in addition to the bread crises that resulted in the repeated interruptions of the roads that connect the camp to the city center because of the bombing and the repeated clashes in the neighboring areas.

A large number of people in Al Aeden camp in Hama came out in a solidarity demonstration , in solidarity with the people of Gaza, where protesters have raised Palestine flags and banners and condemned the Arabian and international silence about what is happening in the Gaza strip.
