Recent Updates

The 3-year- Palestinian girl Ilaf Ammar Nassif and her 35-year-mother Aisha al-Sharif died after due to bombing targeted Muzeireeb town the day before yesterday, as well as the 40-year- Palestinian Samer Yahya Sari died in the same bombing.



The Syrian warplanes dropped two explosive barrels at Muzeireeb yesterday, which inhabited with about 8,500 Palestinian refugees, while the shelling resulted in massive destruction of buildings and property.

In a related context the Palestinian media activist Tariq Ziad Khader, 29 years, from Daraa camp, also died in the bombing of the camp the day before yesterday. He is a reporter for one of the media organizations of the armed opposition groups, and activist of human rights, originally from Ain Ghazal village in Haifa.

Moreover, Syrian warplanes targeted Daraa camp and its vicinity southern Syria with missiles and explosive barrels the day before yesterday, while two barrels resulted in victims and a number of wounded



among civilians, as warplanes launched two air raids on the camp and resulted in massive destruction in homes and property.

On the other hand, a mortar shell was dropped next to the home of the Palestinian refugee "Mahmoud Melhem" in Adhamiya district in Aleppo, resulting in material damage in the home, while the AGPS reporter confirmed that there were no injuries from the family.



It is worthy to mention that the AGPS documented 1032 victims out of 2975 victims from the Palestinian refugees who died due to bombing in Syria, where it documented 206 victims at Aleppo governorate due to several reasons.

In a different context, the suffering of Palestinian refugees who fled Handarat camp 837 days ago is still continues, where they left their houses due to the control of the Syrian Opposition on their camp. The residents of the camp suffer of cruel living situation after they were



requested to leave the Ninth Unit that they live in at the University City in Aleppo, which increased their tragedy and suffering.

Handarat camp and the adjacent areas are still imposed to bombing and violent clashes between the Syrian Military Opposition and the Regular Army alongside Al Quds Brigade, where the Regular Army seeks to control the camp, which forms a strategic point for the Army. The Syrian Opposition Groups seek to be heading for Handarat town and Aleppo Central Prison.

Italy

Routers reported that at least 40 migrants died after apparently getting trapped and suffocating in the water-logged hold of a fishing boat in the Mediterranean, the Italian navy said on Saturday.



The victims are thought to have suffocated after inhaling fumes from fuel after the boat took on water in the hold, the captain of the navy ship leading the rescue said on Italian state television.



Commander Massimo Tozzi, speaking from the ship, said that when his men boarded the migrant boat they found the dead in the hold "immersed in water, fuel and human excrement".

He added that the ship rescued more than 300 migrants including women and children. The agencies didn't mention the nationalities of the victims till moment.

Numbers and Statistics till 15/8/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 775 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 844 days, water was cut for 334 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 655 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 636 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 837 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 481 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
