Hungary

A number of Palestinian activists launched a distress call to help the Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Omar" who was seriously injured in his foot when he was in Syria due to the deteriorating living and health conditions, refugee "Ahmed Omar" was forced to put his life at risk to reach Europe but the strict procedures led to the stranding of him and hundreds of refugees at the Hungarian borders.



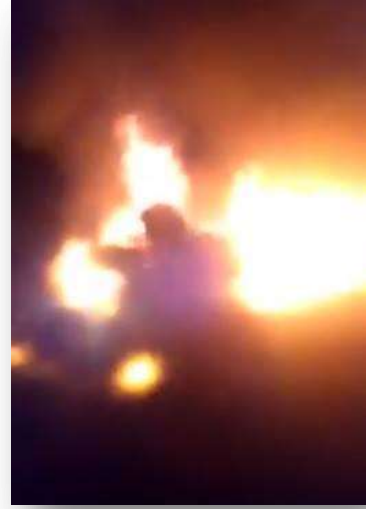
Activists stressed the need to communicate with European NGOs to help "Ahmad" whom his life began to deteriorate due to his delay at the border without any medical care. As well as, activists asked for helping "Ahmad" to cross the Hungarian borders and to complete his way towards North Europe.

Recent Updates

The correspondent of the AGPS transmitted the news of the fall of helicopter aircraft pre- Syrian regime on the outskirts of Al- Nairab camp in Aleppo. As a result of this, many casualties fall among civilians as well as the existence of materialistic damages to some residents' homes near the plane crash. "Loud explosion occurred on Monday night – Tuesday across Al- Neirab camp in Aleppo Province causing a state of panic and fear among people.



It was found that the reason behind this sound is the explosion of a helicopter after being targeted by the Syrian armed opposition by a missile", Said AGPS correspondent. He added that the plane that crashed on the outskirts of the camp, which led to the injury of some people with slight injuries including elderly, "Abu Luay Shurayh" and a five-year-old child who was taken to the cultural center in the camp for treatment.



It is noteworthy that the tense security situation in the city of Aleppo and Al- Neirab camp is negatively reflected on the residents of the camp and their movement in which many of whom fell victims and wounded by the continuation of the war in Syria.

In Damascus, residents of the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees organized yesterday a solidarity march with Al-Aqsa Mosque in which they roamed in the streets of the camp denouncing the international ,Arab ,and Muslim towards the ongoing violations against the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Islamic sanctities are experiencing in occupied Palestine and the attempts of judaization as well as dividing and imposing control over it. Solidarities carried placards condemning the Israeli violations and practices against Al-Aqsa mosque, written on it: "We are to sacrifice ourselves for Jerusalem", "Jerusalem is in danger".



Turning to Damascus suburb, residents of Khan Danoun camp in Damascus suburb live in , since more than two months, a crisis to get a loaf of bread due to reducing the flour quantity and fuel provided to the ovens of the camp, said AGPS correspondent.

Hundreds of people gather daily for long hours in front of the ovens to get a bundle of bread which represents their daily sustenance. The residents of Khan Danoun camp complained in the recent period from its bad quality and the occurrence of some insects such as worms.

The residents demanded the Syrian government and the concerned authorities to provide bread material because it is essential for them and they cannot dispense or replace it with another substance. As well as, they demanded to increase the allocations of flour for the camp's ovens and to hold the owners of furnaces who only care to earn materialistic profit. The residents of Khan Danoun camp are suffering from a severe crisis in diesel and in domestic gas in addition to power outages for long hours up to more than 16 hours a day.



In Daraa Camp south of Syria, the living and health situations are still deteriorated due to the frequent bombing and clashes since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria. The frequent bombing and clashes led to damage about 70% of the camp's buildings, where the remaining refugees live in inhumane and dangerous situations manifested in the health and living sides.

In terms of health, there are no hospitals or medical center in the camp in addition to the lack of medicine and medical materials of the first aid, moreover, the unavailability of ambulances to carry the injured people to get treatment out of the camp. In case that one of the injured people succeeded to get out of the camp, Jordan refuses the entry of any Palestinian refugee from Syria even if he was an injured person. In front of that health reality, a number of activists inside the camp warned from the spread of diseases amongst the residents especially when they are obliged to sue the polluted drinking water due to the water cut since about 511 days.

In terms of living situation, the residents of Daraa camp suffer from the power cut for long periods in addition to the lack of fuel and the heating



materials and losing food materials and the high prices of the remaining materials. It is worth to mention that the frequent bombing and the living situation obliged hundreds of Palestinian families from the camp to resort to the neighboring countries.

Turkey

Turkish Media sources insured that 22migrants died in Aegean Sea due to the capsizing of their boat in front of the Turksih coasts yesterday. The migrants were trying to reach Kos Island in Greece, where the boat sank in front of the peninsula of Datca and not far from Bodrum Resort that the Syrian Child Ilan Kurdi was found near the resort since two weeks.



Malaysia

Despite the appeals that were launched by the Palestinian activist Ibrahim Abu Kharj, who is from Yarmouk camp, and his family to the International and Palestinian organizations to work to release him, however, the Malaysian authorities still size him for the sixth day respectively in Kuala Lumpur Airport and prevent him to enter its lands



after leaving it to migrate to Europe but he was captured by the Cambodian Police and returned back to Malaysia. It is referred that dozens of Palestinian Syrian refugees suffer for the difficulty to get a legal residency in Malaysia due to the strict laws of residencies.

Numbers and Statistics till 15/9/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 805 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 875 days, water was cut for 365 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 667 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 868 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 512 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
