### “Al Nusra Expands its Controlled Areas in Yarmouk after Violent Clashes”



- A Festival and a Solidarity Vigil in the Yarmouk and Babbila Camps for Jerusalem

## Recent Updates

Al-Nusra Front announced through "Twitter" that it controlled a new area in the Yarmouk camp which is besieged by the regular army and PFGC groups.

Al-Nusra said that its members carried out a military operation, the day before yesterday, and killed a large number of regime forces and Palestinian military groups, while the regular army fired artillery shells at people's homes.



Violent clashes broke out the day before yesterday in Yarmouk between the regular army and Palestinian groups on the one hand and Daash and Al-Nusra Front on the other hand.

In a related context residents of Yarmouk established a popular festival under the title "third intifada towards independence and return," supporting of their families in the occupied territories and Jerusalem, where dozens of young people gathered in Youth Support Center, waving banners in solidarity with people of Jerusalem.



Palestinian activities were organized in the vicinity of Babbila town adjacent to Yarmouk the day before yesterday in solidarity with the Al-Aqsa Mosque, which included speeches and poetry, in addition to a short theatrical show.



On the other hand, the Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee "Walid Abdul Ghaffar" from Khan Dannon camp while returning from work yesterday, and taken him to an unknown destination.

It is noteworthy that residents of Khan Dannun camp have been harassed by members of the regular army checkpoint and affiliated groups, while a resident described it with (non-moral).

A resident of the camp - who refused to mention his name for fear of arrest - said to our correspondent in the camp that the checkpoint members frequently harassed girls with non-moral words and movements, in addition to stealing people's things and imposing royalties.



In Aleppo, hundreds of people from Nairab camp came out afternoon in solidarity marches with Al-Aqsa Mosque and the people of Jerusalem, who are subjected to fierce attack by the occupation.

Marches roamed the streets of the camp, and raised the flags of Palestine, as the protestors raised slogans supporting of people of Palestine and Jerusalem cheers.

Neirab camp is under the control of the regular army and groups of al-Quds Brigade, and it is relatively calm, while residents are complaining of the security tightening and the repeated arrest campaigns.



### **Statistics**

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented more than 3031 Palestinian Syrian refugees died because of the war in Syria.



Bombing killed 1052 Palestinian refugees, while 671 refugees died due to clashes between the regular army and the Syrian armed opposition groups, while 421 refugees died due to torture in prisons of the Syrian regime.

### **Numbers and Statistics till 16/10/2015:-**

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 837 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 907 days, water was cut for 397 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 698 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 899 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 543 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
