### *"News about a death sentence for the Palestinian Engineering Basil Khartabeil Al Safadi in the Syrian Prisons"*

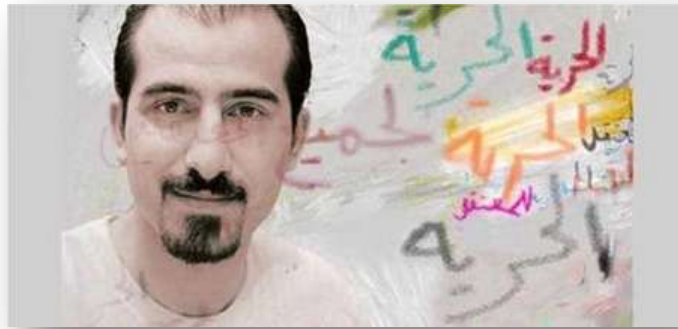

### **Recent Updates**

*The AGPS received news reported that the Syrian authorities have sentenced death to the Palestinian Syrian software engineer "Basil Khartabeil Al Safadi," while the news was not confirmed yet.*

*Al Safadi had been detained for three years and seven months in Adra prison then was transferred to an unknown destination; he is a blogger and software developer leader in Creative Commons in Syria and an activist in projects such as Mozilla, Firefox, and Wikipedia. There is no information so far that he has been executed or not yet.*



*The Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Shaheen" died during clashes between the regular army alongside the pro-regime al-Quds Brigade and armed opposition groups in Family House area west of the city of Aleppo.*

*Meanwhile, the Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Samara" was shot in the arm while participating in the clashes. The two refugees are members of al-Quds Brigade at Nairab camp in Aleppo.*

*It is noteworthy that the people of Nairab have warned that the actions of the Syrian army and al-Quds Brigade will immerse the camp directly in the conflict.*



*The camp witnesses recently an active operational movement of the pro-regime al-Quds Brigade loyal to the Syrian regime, as it held meetings under the leadership of its boss called "Mohammed Saeed," while tanks of the Syrian army going through the camp towards the airport.*



*In the south of Damascus, the Palestinian refugee Waseem Sharaan from the Yarmouk camp was shot in the head at Yalda area by a sniper of Al Nusra Front.*

*The Palestinian refugee, "Wadea Al Shakoush," was arrested from his home in Jadedat Artouz area in Damascus suburb by the Syrian security forces, as he was taken to an unknown destination. He is from Khan Al Sheikh camp in Damascus suburb.*





*It is noteworthy that residents of Khan Al Shieh camp have been subjected recently by the Syrian security and detained at its checkpoints in Sehnaya and Jadedat Artouz, in addition to the entrances to Khan Al Shieh camp, where the Syrian security continuously checks the residents who enter or exit from the camp.*

*In the meantime, the Syrian security released the Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Ismail Al Omor" after being detained for about six months, while the Syrian security forces continue to arrest 178 refugees from Al Aedein camp along with hundreds of Palestinian refugees who are still unaccounted for.*

### ***Numbers and Statistics till 16/11/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 868 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 938 days, water was cut for 428 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 729 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 930 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 574 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
