"Al Yarmouk Residents Transfer 9 Victim's Bodies Buried at a Public Garden in the Camp"

Victims

The Palestinian refugee "Mahmoud Diab," 28 years, from Al Aedein camp died due to torture in the Syrian regime's prisons after being detained for two years; his corpse was recognized within the leaked images of the victims of torture in detention centers. The number of victims of torture in Syrian prisons increased to 384 victims who documented by the AGPS.

The Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Abu Rashid," Abu Jihad, died during the clashes that broke out between Aknaf brigades and ISIS groups. Abu Jihad is a member of Aknaf brigades in the besieged Yarmouk camp.

Recent Updates

Dozens of people in the Yarmouk camp transferred 9 Palestinian victims' bodies who were buried in the garden of Abdul-Qader al-Husseini Mosque during the last few days, due to the clashes that broke out after ISIS breaking into Yarmouk. The victims are: "Mohammed Nassar and his wife," "Sana Khalili," "Fethiye Abu Jaweid," "Fouad Ahmad Al-Abdullah, "" Hussein Taha,""Mohammed Tamim," "Jamal Khalifa,"and" Abdul Latif Rimawi."



It is noteworthy that the tombs of the camp have no space forcing parents to bury their victims in simple spaces between graves or in mass burial for the victims, yet it has been targeted by the Syrian army warplanes or mortars.

Sporadic clashes broke out in Yarmouk yesterday, where the battles between Aknaf brigades and ISIS groups are still continuous, while Daash continue to control (80%) of the Yarmouk refugee camp.

In a related context, Dr. Ismile Hanneya ,the deputy head of Hamas political bureau, in a speech yesterday evening during a rally in Gaza City on the occasion of the Palestinian Prisoners Day, confirmed the frequent demands of Hamas movement to neutralize the Palestinian refugees from the ongoing clash in Syria, adding that Hamas will not forget the Palestinian refugee camps, especially the Yarmouk refugee camp. He also noted that the Palestinian refugees are guests in neighboring countries and are waiting for the moment to return to Palestine.

In Damascus suburb, heavy shelling and heavy gunfire targeted "Zakia - Khan Al Shieh" road, where Shilka tanks of the Syrian regime opened fire against the road during the presence of dozens of residents, which led to a number of injuries amid reports about victims. The shelling coincided with heavy shelling targeted the town of Zakia and the neighboring areas.

It is noteworthy that "Zakia - Khan Al Shieh" is the only way for the remaining people in Yarmouk which they can access the capital Damascus, after the Syrian regime closed all other roads, which reflected negatively on the lives of the people, as most basic materials were lost, where other materials' prices have risen dramatically.

Civil Work Committees

World Relief Organization and the Charity Committee for Relief of the Palestinian people" are distributing "1000" food rations as well as bread and baby milk to families displaced from the Yarmouk refugee camp to the adjacent town of Yalda.

It is noteworthy that the siege of the Yarmouk refugee camp by the Syrian army and Palestinian groups loyal to it is still continue for 649 days respectively, power cut for more than (729) days, and water cut for 219 days respectively. Meanwhile, the people in the Yarmouk refugee

camp and the displaced are suffering from a severe shortage of food and medical supplies, high prices, absence of financial resources and the spread of unemployment, while aid and food baskets became their only source of living.

Numbers and Statistics till 16/4/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - *Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 649 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 729 days, water was cut for 219 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 175 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 550 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 520 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - *Residents have left the camp for 720 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - *It is now almost 366days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - *A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - *Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
