VICTIMS

The Palestinian refugee “Mohammad Adnan Khzaa’i” was killed while fighting alongside the Syrian regime in Damascus Countryside province, as well as the refugee “Saeed Khaled Anbousi” 37-years-old who was killed in Lattakia Coutryside.



RECENT UPDATES

“Shield” Organization on protection of rights and freedoms of citizens in Ukraine, assured that the Palestinian baby “Jaafar Azzouz” was found alive in an orphanage in Silopi region in Turkey, and it will be working on sending him back to his remaining relatives after he lost his parents “Aaminah Saleh” and “Imad Azzouz” who were shot dead while crossing the Turkish borders on 14 February 2016.

“Ukraine in Arabic” News website reported about two meetings brought together both Dr. Saleh Daher the “Shield” director and his senior advisor Mr. Matiakin





with Mr. Jemil Ufuk Turgul the Turkish General Consulate in Odessa concerning this issue.

On 16 March 2016 during the second meeting, the Turkish Consulate asked for Legal power of attorney from the child's family to start the process of delivering, according to "Sheild".

It is noteworthy that the General Assembly for Palestinian Refugees of Syrian Interim Government had mentioned, previously, receiving confirmation from Turkish Authorities about the child's death and burial occurrence.

To Gaza Strip, where a group of Palestinian refugees living in Gaza received, yesterday, Palestinian Authority passports from the local government. This comes while the suffering continues in terms of living conditions and the so-called "Neglect" against them by the government as well as the UNRWA and the PLO.

It is noteworthy that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families "returned" to Gaza coming from Egypt after Syria.

Al-Wafaa European Campaign in cooperation with the "Al-Waqf Foundation" from Netherlands distributed food aid to PRS families living in Adana City south of Turkey, while "The Islamic Association" from Palestine 1948 lands distributed cash assistance as well as meat parcels to families in Mersin, where it intends to continue towards Iskandaron, Kilis and Reyhanli Cities, according to the association officials.



It is noteworthy that the number of PRS in Turkey is estimated at 6.000 to 8.000 refugees living in Istanbul and provinces of mid and south Turkey according to the AGPS' semi-annual report issued last January.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 17 March 2016

- *15,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan,*
- *6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 1006 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1067 days, water cut for 556 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 862 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1053 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 716 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al-Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
