“ICRC Manage to Enter Limited Quantities of Medical Aids to the Yarmouk Camp”



- After the security raided the house of a Palestinian Refugee, his relatives announced that they loss half a million SL.
- Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon sit-in in front of the UNRWA Office in Sour city, protesting on the cut of financial aids.
- Palestinian and Syrian refugees on hunger strike protesting on being forced to leave their fingerprints in Italy.

Recent Updates

A committee of the ICRC has managed to enter about 50 parcels of urgent medical aids to the Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus, it is worth mentioning that all the hospitals in the Yarmouk Camp stopped working due to the strict siege imposed by the Regular Army and Groups of PFGC since 470 days which resulted in the death of 155 refugees. Meanwhile, the residents were gathered at Al Rija square to receive the food aids provided by UNRWA, since the food parcels distribution has been resumed.

Thus, snipers opened their fire during the aids distribution and targeted Al Yarmouk Main Street. In Homs, members of the Syrian security raided the house of the refugee “Mohammed Isa Shatara” from Al Aedein Camp, as they searched his house and took half a million SL, which equals 2600\$, according to a relative. Eyewitness said that the forces raided the house coinciding with Al Jomaa pray, which led to crowds in front of the house.

As in Italy, the Palestinian and Syrian refugees, who are detained in the refugee centers in Italy, are complaining of being forced to leave their fingerprints under the threat of violence. A number of activists circulated photographs of injured Palestinian and Syrian refugees after they were beaten and forced to fingerprint.



In the same context, about 300 Palestinian and Syrian refugee on hunger strike in Cecilia town, to express their refusal of leaving their fingerprints in Italy, since the fingerprints affects their asylum to another European countries. As in Germany, reports referred to the finding of the young man, "Omar Ahmad Sanad " from the Khan Al Sheih camp in a camp for minors in Germany, they found him after his parents launched appeals through the social media websites on internet to know his place and the cause behind his appearance for more the about a month while he was heading to Italy.

Lebanon

The Palestinian Displaced Committee from Syria to Lebanon carried out a sit-in in front of the UNRWA Office, refusing the UNRWA decision to cut the financial aids of hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families who are displaced from Syria to Lebanon. The protesters handed out a memorandum to the Head of the UNRWA Office in Sour city MR. Fawzi Kassab, after they assure their refusal of the injustice decision of depriving more than 1100 families from the relief program and the monthly aids provided by UNRWA. The memorandum stressed to reject the unjust standards relied upon by the Agency of its decision, also called for reconsideration of the decision by increasing the size of the aids.

The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - *The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 470 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 552 days and the water cut for 39 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 371 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 340 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:***-*The residents left the camp since 540 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - *Almost 186 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:***-*bombing targeted the vicinity of the Camp and the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except the Zakia road.*
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - *economic crises continue specially the unemployment and the high prices.*
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - *the power is still cut for more than a year.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - *relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.*
