“Bombing at Al Yarmouk and Alnairab Refugee Camps and shelling with Explosive Barrels in the Vicinity of Khan Al Shieh and Khan Danon Camps”



The effects of the explosive barrels in the Vicinity of the Khan Sheikh

- A Palestinian was killed after a bombing in Syria.
- Active organizations and institutions in the Yarmouk refugee camp condemn the assassination of "Abu Abed Shmedin".
- Continuing with his hunger strike, the Palestinian Ambassador in Budapest meet Rakan Hussein.
- Chairman of the Lebanese Palestinian Dialogue Committee, "what is spent on Palestinians in Lebanon barely keep their lives".

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Victims

Hossam Abu Tahawas was killed after the bombing, which targeted Zamalka area in Damascus city the day before, mentioned that five Palestinians, including three victims from the same family died after the bombing of Zamalka.

Recent Updates

Mortar shells targeted the Yarmouk refugee Camp in Damascus City, where a shell landed on Moroccans street causing limited material damages. in the same context, civil institutions and organizations and civil society in Yarmouk refugee camp, convicted, in a statement, the assassination of "Abu Abed Hmedin" who was assassinated the day before with a silencer gun near Abdul Kader Hussein mosque inside the camp, where bodies and institutions confirmed that they will make efforts to try to detect the perpetrators of the crime, as the families of the deceased demanded restraint, wisdom and patience.



It is worth mentioning that the camp is still exposed to the siege by members of the Regular Army and the PFLP - General Command for more than ten months.

On the other hand, a number of home-made rockets targeted Alnairab camp in Aleppo, which led to a massive destruction in people's homes. A state of discontent spread among the residents of the camp after targeting their homes frequently with shells and homemade rockets.

During the Last twenty days, about eighty rockets and shells, targeted the camp causing material damage to the homes and property of civilians, in addition to a number of injuries, coincided with the announcement of a Syrian opposition armed Brigades on social networking sites that Nairab camp is one of the military areas of the regime that will be targeted.

It is noteworthy that the camp is fully controlled by the Syrian Army, as the camp is considered the only crossing for Regular Forces and



machines from Aleppo to each of Aleppo International and military airports. Members of the Regular Army and some members of the Popular Committees supporting the Army to buy its needs from Nairab camp markets.

People in the Nairab camp live in a state of anxiety and stress because of their fear of the Regular Army and the Popular Committees who are based imposing strict security measures on them, and brigades armed opposition, which considered the camp one of the regime regions.

In Khan Al Sheih Camp Damascus City violent explosions were heard, turned out to be caused by the bombing of the surrounding farms with explosive barrels. The camp suffers from frequent interruptions for roads that connect between the camp and the city center because of the clashes and acts of repeated shelling, resulted in reduction of many food materials of its markets.

Teeba town in Damascus city, neighboring to Khan Dannoun camp, also was bombed with a number of mortar shells which led to the spread of a



state of anxiety among residents, the camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families displaced from the camps because of the bombardment and siege and neighboring regions strained significant security during the past few days.

Hungary

Rakan Hussein, Palestinian refugee, continues to hunger strike for the sixth day respectively, to protest against the obstruction of Hungarian authorities to reunite with his children due to lack of recognition of the Hungarian authorities of his sons passports, as the Palestinian Ambassador in Hungary "Marie Antoinette" met "Rakan" Yesterday, where the Ambassador looked on his suffering, during the meeting.

"Rakan" stated to the Action Group reporter in Budapest that the ambassador promised to grant his children Palestinian passports and try to solve his problem during the next two weeks, stressing that she will do her best in this matter, even if she has to travel to Ramallah for that, it is noteworthy that "Hussein" had transferred his sit-in from the refugee camp to the International Red Cross Headquarter in Budapest.

Lebanon

The President of the Lebanese Palestinian Dialogue Committee, former minister Hassan Mneimneh, declared that “to bear the burden of the whole Palestinian and Syrian displacement become unaffordable to Lebanon, since the displacement Palestinian and Syrian has become nearly half of the Lebanese themselves, which represents a large exhaustion of Lebanon infrastructure, public services and economic and social conditions of Lebanon, especially with the absence of real support from the international community.

Mr. Munaimnah pointed out that the issue of Palestinian refugees is at the heart of human suffering, and there are needs and necessities cannot be delayed or cut, what is up to the Palestinians, does not spent on luxury, but pours in channel of maintaining their minimum of human dignity, may be less, and any negligence or omission in this matter, from any of us, lends things up to the deterioration of health and security, and the ethical, moral and political explosion, which may result serious things cannot be controlled.

It is worth mentioning that Mr. Munaimnah statements came during the regular session meetings of the annual conference of the Advisory Committee of UNRWA.

In a related context, UNRWA announced their need to 27 million U.S. dollars to assist and relief the Palestinian refugees in Syria During the holy month of Ramadan, in a press conference of the New Commissioner-General of UNRWA””, held in Amman after the opening session of the Advisory Committee UNRWA.

MR. Krenpol stressed that launching this appeal on the eve of Ramadan is an indication that UNRWA is committed to provide a decent life for about 400 thousand Palestinian refugees, registered in Syria.

Pierre Krenpol pointed out that thousands of Palestinian refugees are at risk of exposure to hunger because they do not have enough money to buy food where livelihoods have been destroyed, as well as their homes.

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Action Group For Palestinians of Syria



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"Krenpol" said that all the people who remained in Syria, population of 460 thousand people, have been affected by the Syrian crisis and they need ongoing humanitarian assistance in order to meet their basic needs, adding that at least half of those people had fled from their homes, and in some cases it was more than once.
