Recent Updates

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria launched a campaign on the social media websites and pages to collect the names and information about the Palestinian refugees who were lost while they were trying to reach Europe through the so called boats of death. The Action Group prepared an electronic form to fill it with information about the missing people. It is mentioned that several boats have been sunk in the sea which were launched from Libya and Egypt.

In a different context, the water crises in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees continues increasing where the camp suffers of water cut since nine days and that increased the living crises in the besieged camp for more than 425 days. It is mentioned that the siege is imposed on the camp by the Regular Army and the PFGC and prevented the entry and exit of the camp's residents except allowing a limited quantity of aids to enter the camp. In the same context, aids were distributed yesterday on the besieged people of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus.



The water pump operators in the Yarmouk camp, which is stopped since three years, launched an initiative to solve the water crises in the Yarmouk camp and the surrounding areas through calling the Syrian Government and the responsible people to supply the station with electricity and the station will pump water to the areas of the Syrian Regime. The initiative people called all concerned side to adapt the project and contact them to end the water crises in the Yarmouk camp.

Al Sbeina camp residents in Damascus city are still prevented to return back to their houses by the Regular Army checkpoints and Palestinian factions loyal to it, where there are no clear reasons for the prevention. The Syrian Army completely controls these camps after clashed that broke out between the Regular Army alongside with Palestinian faction loyal to it and the Free Army, the clashes led to the control of the Regular Army over Al Sbeina camp since November 2013. It is mentioned that the residents of the camp were distributed on the surrounding camps and towns which added more of economic burdens especially with the high coast of rent houses and the spread of unemployment.

In Qudseyya in Damascus city, the Regular Army closes the roads that connect Qudseyya with the surrounding areas for the second day respectively where it prevents the entry of food materials and flour into the town. It is referred that the town receives hundreds of displaced Palestinian families most of them are from the Yarmouk camp.

In Dara'a, The residents complain of the severe shortages of the health and basic services in the camp due to the huge destruction of the camp's infrastructure in addition to destroying most of the camp houses because of the frequent bombing which led dozens of families to leave the camp to the surrounding areas especially Al Muzareeb town.

Lebanon

A state of resentment spread amongst Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon because of the UNRWA decision to cut its financial aids on hundreds of the displaced Palestinians of Syria to Lebanon which increases their living crises. The Palestinian Association for Human Rights "witness" demanded UNRWA to cancel its arbitrary decision.

The statement of Witness organization came after the Association received a delegation from the Palestinian Syrians in Lebanon Committee that complain about the decision through the Witness Association about the UNRWA decision of cutting the financial aids of the displaced Palestinians of Syria families in Lebanon. The UNRWA justified its arbitrary decision that the families became undeserved for these aids due to a field survey that the UNRWA performed, the survey was filled of lots of remarks.



Civil Work Committees

The Give Charity for Relief and Development in coordination with the organizations and the commissions inside the Yarmouk camp and within the project of the School Bag 2014-2015 prepared 300 school bags to be distributed on the school students who joined the schools on 14th of September 2014.

In a deferent context, on the 15th of September 2014, the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Ein Al Helwa camp in cooperation with the Palestinian Syrian Workers League opened a project of rehabilitating the abandoned house shelter which contains displaced Palestinians of Syria to Lebanon. The rehabilitation contains painting the walls and maintenance to the health facilities and lights.

Missing

Mohammed Ghassoub Najeeb 55 years was missed during his return back from Al Swayeda to Al Nairab camp in his car where he was kidnapped by unknown groups, and his destiny is still unknown.
