Recent Updates

Two Palestinian Syrian refugees died due to the continuance of the war events in Syria, on 18-4-2017, the refugee Omar Helweh died due to the absence of medicine because of the siege policies applied by the Syrian Regime and its affiliated groups in AL-Tal City in Damascus.

The Refugee Omar Helweh was displaced to Al-Tal after fighting and bombing act between the Regime and the Opposition in Haresta area in Damascus Suburb, he was buried in Qudseya area as he has three sons. AGPS documented 195 Palestinian refugee's Victims, who died due to siege and hunger in Syria and most of them died in the besieged Yarmouk Camp.



The refugee, who was known as Abu Husam Al Shabah, one of the members of Al Sham Liberation Organization due to the clashes between ISIS and Al Sham Organization in the center of Haifa street at Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus, which raises the toll number of Palestinian victims, who died since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria, to 3500 victims. The AGPS correspondent reported that violent



clashes broke out between ISIS and Al Sham Liberation Organization yesterday.

The Clashes were due to the ISIS attempt to invade Haifa street, where they used the medium-weapons and firebombs, coincided with the targeting of Al Kara'een Groups in Palestine Street by the Syrian Regime with several shells, causing material damages but leaving no casualties. It is noted that ISIS is still controlling 60% of Yarmouk Camp, where the stricken siege on Yarmouk by the Syrian Regime and the PFGC, now it is 1399 days respectively.

The Day before in Southern Syria, the Syrian Regime targeted Al Muzareeb town in Der'aa western Suburb with several mortar shells. The AGPS correspondent confirmed that the Regime targeted Al Muzareeb with 8 mortar shells, hit separate places in the town and led to the death of a Syrian from Al Jolan. It is referred that Al Muzareeb includes about 1700 Palestinian families, who live in a difficult humanitarian situation due to the siege and the absence of the financial resources in addition to the high prices.

The Palestine Red Crescent Society in Lebanon – Safad Hospital in cooperation with the Qatar Red Crescent, the Palestine Children Relief and the American Syrian Medical Society declared the arrival of the humanitarian Spanish medical delegations for orthopedic Surgical Operations for the Palestinian Syrian children in Lebanon, under 18 years old. The Society said that the delegation work period is from 19-5 to 21-5 2017, the society added that the patients' medical check will start on Friday at 9 am and the surgeries will start on Saturday.



It is mentioned that the delegation will provide the orthopedic surgeries for free for the Palestinian Syrian children in Lebanon. It is referred that hospitalization service is considered amongst the most prominent problems and challenges that the displaced Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon face, where the suffering of the lack of the hospitalization services specially after the relief organizations and the local organization reduced their service due to the continuance of war in Syria.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 18\05\2017

- *The AGPS documented 3500 Palestinian victims, including 461 women.*
- *1603 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 99 women.*
- *The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1399 consecutive days.*
- *196 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.*

- *It is now more than 1130 days without water in Deraa camp, and 981 days in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 1474 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 208 days.*
- *Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.*
