Victims

Each of "Abdullah Khneifis," "Abdul Rahman Saeed Khneifis," and "Nabil AwadFaris", died after being kidnapped from Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus suburbby groups affiliated to Al Nusra Front about 7 months ago. According to residents, AlNusra arrested three refugees without giving any reason, as any evidence was not proved of their involvement in any event, while Al Nusra did not clarified the reasons of arrest.

It is mentioned that Al Nusra Front and groups affiliated to the Syrian armed opposition have implemented previous arrest and assassination campaigns against what they called dealers with the Syrian regime.

Recent Updates

"Abu Ahmed," a leaderof AknafBrigades in the Yarmouk camp, stated that ISIS and AL Nusra are confused, as some cases of escape were recorded amongst their members.

In an exclusive statement for a Palestinian newspaper, "Abu Ahmed" mentioned that "Aknaf succeeded in restoring blocks near the Salah al-Din Ayoubimosque, which was controlled previously by ISIS. He also clarified that Aknaf is still besieging the security square of Al Nusra at Palestine square, stressing deaths and wounded in its ranks.

Adding that "Aknaf, in cooperation with the SFA, regained the initiative of the camp in which ISIS controls 70% of its area."



"Abu Ahmed" also mentioned that Aknaf fighters had killed 60 fighters of ISIS in violent battles in more than one axis, within 18 days of breaking into the camp.

"There is coordination between Aknaf and the operations' room of Yarmouk Resident' victory of the Syrian opposition, he continued, "We decided to eradicate ISIS out of the camp and the south of Damascus, noting the full names of the members who involved in the assassination of activists, and had a role in its downfall, as saying."

He urged the necessity of activating the popular mobilization in order to expel ISIS and Al Nusra coincide with military operations that are led by AKnaf with the Syrian opposition factions to expel them, calling for the need to activate the humanitarian and emergency relief assistance to the people of the camp.

He stressed that Aknaf Brigades are still steadfast in their battle against ISIS and it strives to drive it outside the camp, all the way to maintain it, to neutralize it, and to return its displaced families.

In the same context, ISIS has burnt and damaged some musical instruments belonging to the Palestinian artist "Ayham Al-Ahmad" from Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus, provoking a wave of criticism among residents and activists, who

consider that "Al-Ahmad" is one of the most prominent art symbols during the period of the siege for more than 650 days.

It is noteworthy that "Al-Ahmad" and his band had issued a number of songs that described the case of besieged refugees in the Yarmouk refugee camp, where he plays the piano inside the devastating neighborhoods, as he participated in many global events pro-Yarmouk camp.

Families and friends of the detained refugee "AmjadAl Hindi- Abu Ayyub" demanded Al Nusra Front to immediately release him, where Al Nusra kidnapped him on 29th of March, despite the intervention of a number of bodies inside the camp to try to persuade Al Nusrs, but the latter kept quiet about his fate.

It is noteworthy that Amjad is from the besieged Yarmouk camp, and provide his disable mother.

Belgium

Dozens of Palestinians and protestors gathered in solidarity with the Yarmouk refugee camp, yesterday, in front of the EU headquarters in Brussels, Belgium, where protestors expressed their solidarity with their besieged families in the Yarmouk refugee camp, calling all human rights and relief agencies to work in order to end the suffering of the people of Yarmouk.

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria Statistics

The Documented statistics on the AGPS website, "actionpal.org.uk," indicate that the bombing is first cause of death among the Palestinian refugees in Syria, where it led to the death of (998) victims, while the armed clashes is the second cause, as it led to the death of (598) victims. Torture to death is the third place, as the AGPS documented (380) names of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime.

Numbers and Statistics till 18/4/2015

- *The toll of the Palestinian victims who were documented by name, place, and reason of death by the AGPS has reached 2824.*
- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 651 days respectively. In addition, power cuts*

continued for more than 731 days, water was cut for 221 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 175 victims.

- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 552 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 522 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 722 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 368 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
