"Ahmed Mohammed Zahra" a PLA honor lieutenant died due to previous shot in a bombing that targeted Arnous Square in Damascus area three days ago, it is noted that he was in a vacation and he is from the residents of Rokn Al Dein area in Damascus, Shekh Khalid area, and he was buried there.

Mohammed Mahmoud Yousef Qasim died by snipers in Jisr area northwest province of Idlib Syria, which is witnessing heavy fighting between the Syrian army and the Syrian armed opposition groups, His body was transferred to a hospital near the city of Hama, he is one of the displaced from Hndarat camp in Aleppo to Shaghour bridge.

Europe

The AGPS documentation and monitoring team insured that the number of the Palestinians of Syria who fled to Europe during 2011 till June 2015 is 36450 refugees according to the UNHCR. In details, about 2465 Palestinian Syrian refugees reached Europe during 2011, where 3513



reached during 2012. The Number was increased to 9620 refugees in 2013 and continued in 2014 to reach 13902 refugees according to the UNHCR.

The estimated numbers refer to that 6950 Palestinian Syrian refugees reached Europe during the first half of 2015. It is worthy to mention that most of the Palestinian Syrian refugees who reached Europe through death boats risking their lives and the children life asking for stability and safety especially after most of the countries prevented their entry to their territories.

Recent Updates

Daraa camp for Palestinian refugees in South of Syria witnessed separate clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition armed groups, Coincided with the exploding one of the tunnels of the Regular Army by the Opposition to prevent the army to reach the centers of the Opposition forces in the camp and its vicinity.

Where the suffering of the residents of the camp continues where there are no relief services inside the camp due to the lack of medical services. It is worthy to mention that the official statistics refer to that 70% of the camp's building were exposed to damages due to the frequent bombing that target the camp.

Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb vicinity was exposed yesterday to bombing by the Regular Army where violent clashes broke out between the Regular Army and the Opposition forces. The residents of the camp were committed to neutralization since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria but the deteriorated situation of the surrounding areas let the resident live in fear and worry from unknown situation especially with the close clashes from their camp.

The Suffering of the camp residents and hundreds of families that fled to the camp during the last years running from the bombing and siege, where their suffering is concentrated on the economic and medical sides, most of the camp's residents depend on the relief help in securing the food to their children after they lost their work.

In terms of medicine, the residents complain of the lack of medical and relief services inside the camp and it is noted that Khan Danoun camp is considered from the poorest camps.

In north of Syria, the Syrian security released a bus passengers heading from Al Nairab camp to Turkey which they seized them the day before at Aleppo Airport while they were trying to leave the camp. The Syrian security kept three youth under the pretext of not serving with PLA compulsory service. The Syrian security issued its orders of preventing Al



Nairab people to travel to the Opposition areas and a number of them were returned back who were heading to Turkey before the last checkpoint of the Syrian regime.

It is worthy to mention that thousands of Palestinian refugees escaped the ongoing war in Syria after what their camps were exposed to such as bombing, destruction, sniping and victims and the following of the Palestinian youth to serve in the PLA in addition to the bad economic situation.

On the other hand, the Palestinian camps in Syria received the first day of Ramadan in difficult living circumstances, siege, bombing, and the prevention of the refugees to return back were the most prominent aspects.

The Syrian Regime and the PFGC groups are still imposing a siege on the Yarmouk camp for 721 days respectively and the ISIS still control wide spaces of the camp since the incursion in April 2015. The Regular Army prevents the residents of Al Husaeneyya camp to return back since 602 days and the residents of Al Sbeina camp since 583 days.

The Regular Army cuts the roads that connect Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus Suburb with Damascus except Zakia –Khan Al Sheih road.

The Syrian Opposition prevents the residents of Handarat camp in Aleppo to return back to their houses since about 785 days and the residents of Jaramana, Al Sayeda Zainab, Al Aedin in Homs, Al Nairab in Aleppo, and Al Raml at Latakia still live in calm and careful state concentrated on their living aspect.



The Residents of Daraa camp suffer of difficult living situations most prominent is the lack of medical and health services inside the camp. In general, thousands of Palestinian Syrian refugees share the same suffering such as housing, unemployment houses rents and the power and water cut.

Numbers and Statistics till 18/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 896 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 721 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 791 days, water was cut for 281 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 602 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 583 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 785 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 428 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
