***“Action Group: 336 Palestinian Women and Girls were killed in Syria till the end of Last November”***



- A Palestinian Syrian refugee was missed in Greece.
- Siege and water cut in the Yarmouk camp are still continuing.
- A state of quietness prevailed Khan Dannon camp in Damascus Suburb.
- 93 victims from Khan AL Sheih camp were killed since the beginning of the war in Syria.
- Relief Agencies try to alleviate the consequences of the services absence in the Yarmouk camp.

### **Recent Updates**

*The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria Documentation team, documented the names of 336 girls and women who were killed during the ongoing war in Syria, where they form about 7% of the Palestinian victims, which were documented by the Action Group that their number is 2564 refugees till the last month.*

*On the other hand, the water cut on the houses of the Yarmouk camp enters its 84th day respectively in light of the continuance of the strict siege which is imposed on the camp by the Regular Army and the PFGC for more than a year and a half, where the residents suffer of huge difficulties in securing their food in addition to the shortage of fuel and the water and power cut on the whole camp.*

*In Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb, a state of quietness prevailed in the camp, where the surrounding areas witnessed increasing military operations during the last period. In terms of living and services, the residents' suffering continues, where they suffer of the crowd and the high cost of fuel and rent houses, in addition to the high prices of food materials.*

*It is referred that hundreds of camps' families and the residents of the surrounding areas were displaced to the camp fleeing from the war and siege.*

*In Khan Al Sheih camp, the Action Group documentation team documented that 93 victims died due to several reasons, Air and artillery bombing is the most prominent reason which led to 54 victims, while 14 victims died due to torture in the Syrian prisons, 13 refugees died due to shooting, 7 victims were kidnapped and then killed, two refugees died due to sniper shots, a refugee was executed in the field, from the residents of the camp, a refugee died due to unknown reasons and a refugee died due to a car bomb.*

*It is mentioned that the camp and its vicinity are suffering of frequent bombing and the continuation of the roads closure which connect the camp with the city center that is negatively reflected on the living situation.*



*On a different context, the Young man Alaa' Adnan Al Sadi , a Palestinian Syrian from the Yarmouk camp, Lubyia Street, was missed during his travel on foot from Greece with some guys to Macedonia where there is no news about him since several days.*

### **Civil Work Committees**

*Under the title" For Cleaner Camp and Normal Life", the services department of Palestine Charity Committee in the Yarmouk camp continue to clean up the streets of the waste and collecting it to be deported to far from the residents places. Meanwhile, the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command continue their strict siege imposed on the camp for more than a year and a half when it ceased All basic services such as electricity and cleaning, and health.*





### ***The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 1/12/2014***

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **514** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **597** days, water was cut for **84** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **157** victims.
- **41** Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.
- **96** PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.
- **Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **416** days respectively.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **386** days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for **586** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost **231** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- **Khan Danoun Camp:** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- **Al Nairab Camp:** - Power is still cut for more than a year.
- **Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
