Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent reported that violent clashes broke out on the parts of Ein Thekr in western Der'aa Suburb, where a big number of Palestinian families live there, between Al Nusra front beside its factions and Yarmouk Martyrs Brigade besides ISIS. They used all kinds of heavy weapons which led to a number of victims and wounded from the two parts.



Hundreds of the Palestinian families who live in south of Syria suffer from inhumane and cruel situations due to the violent clashes and bombing between the military groups in the area and targeting their towns with explosive barrels and rockets. On 4th of April 2016, hundreds of the Palestinians of Syria families left to Wadi Al Yarmouk, Al Ajami and Al Muzareeb town fearing from bombing and shrapnel of the confrontations.

In Damascus Suburb, big numbers of rats were spread out in the streets of Al Husayneyya camp in Damascus Suburb which forms a big threat to



the lives of the residents through the spread of diseases that will increase their suffering. Many residents said that the causes of rats are the garbage in the streets and the destroyed houses and the municipalities and the concerned parties are late in providing services and cleaning the streets which created a good environment for rats to spread.

Activists warned from the spread of insects and diseases such as plague due to the accumulation of garbage. They also demanded the governorate and the municipalities to find a solution for this problem and secure the poison to kill rats and to clean the garbage without being late in order to stop the spread of diseases and causes such as rats specially that summer is coming and the high temperature.

On his turn, a resident of Al Husayneyya camp reported to AGPS the news of an old woman that was exposed to a rat bite and was transferred to a hospital to get treatment



Al Husayneyya camp witnessed bombing with Meg Warplanes that led to victims and wounded and material damages to houses as happened in 17/1/2013 when the warplanes targeted civilians and caused a massacre.



The camp witnessed violent battles between the Regular Army beside its loyal factions and the Opposition before they completely controlled the camp in 9/10/2013.

In a different context, Jafra organization continues providing its services to the displaced residents of Yarmouk camps in Yelda, Bebla, and Bait Sahem besides Yarmouk. The team also cleaned the streets of those areas which are including the families of the Yarmouk camp.

It is mentioned that hundreds of the Palestinian families were displaced from Yarmouk camp due to the invasion of ISIS in the beginning of April 2015 in coordination with Al Nusra members who were available at Yarmouk camp. It is noted that all working relief organizations in Yarmouk stopped their work in the camp due to threats by ISIS which is accused of the assassination of a number of relief activists in the camp.



Under the title “Our Families, Our Responsibility” the Charity organization launched its project to relief the Palestinians in Syria. According to a member of the campaign that in the first day they



distributed 1000 food parcels and 1000 bread packs to the displaced Palestinians in Al Zahera area in Damascus, Jaramana camp in Damascus Suburb, and the Displaced of Yarmouk residents in Yelda and Bebla towns.

In Lebanon, dozens of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon and the concerned civil work committees participated in a press conference to launch the international campaign activities to maintain and keep the Palestinian Identity "Entemaa" and to revive the memory of 68 years of Al Nakba on Monday 18/4/2016 in the Lebanese Journalists Syndicate in Beirut in attendance from a number of Palestinian organizations inside and outside Lebanon.

It is mentioned that Entemaa campaign is a popular campaign sponsored by Palestinian organizations and committees meant to reinforce the belonging to the land of Palestine from the Sea to the river and aims at increasing the national and patriot feeling amongst Palestinian refugees in their various places.

UNRWA in Lebanon filled the ATM Cards of the displaced Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon, they provided 100 USD for rent allowance for each Palestinian refugee family from Syria, and food allowance about 40000 Lebanese Lira about 27 USD for each one.

UNRWA declared that it was able through its rapid appeal to Syria in 2016 to continue its financial services to the Palestinian refugees from Syria in Lebanon and qualified to have the aid like follows; 40000 L.L food allowance for each person. UNRWA mentioned that it will continue



till the end of 2016 and a monthly financial aid 100USD shelter allowance where it will provide a monthly aid from March 2016 till June 2016.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 19\04\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1039 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1099 days, water was cut for 589 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 894 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1087 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 747 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*

- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
