“Clashes in the Vicinity of Al Nairab Camp led to the Cut of the Road leading to it”



Al Nairab Camp

- A Palestinian refugee woman from Al Nairab Camp was killed due to the snipping of the car that she was in.
- An explosive bomb near Al Basil hospital in the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus.
- Al Nosra front issues a decision to prevent smoking in the Yarmouk Camp.
- The Action Group: 2524 Palestinian Syrian refugees were killed till yesterday.
- A state of quietness prevailed Khan Al Sheih Camp in Damascus city in light of the roads crises.

Victims

The Palestinian refugee woman “Ilham Zaki Arrar” from Al Nairab Camp was killed due to wounded she attained in a taxi accident in Aleppo road after shooting it by snipers at Al Amereia area. The Action Group confirms that its documentary team documented 2524 Palestinian refugee victims were killed till yesterday, Sunday 19th of October 2014.

Recent Updates

Clashes broke out in the front of AL Ameriea between the Regular Army and the Syrian opposition forces, which led to the cut of the road that link between Aleppo and Al Nairab Camp due to targeting the road that heading from the Camp to Aleppo with snipers shot.

In the same context the Action Group correspondent reported that a number of Al Quds brigades members, which loyal to the Regular Army, were killed due to the confrontations that broke out yesterday morning on Al Amereia front between the Regular Army and the Syrian opposition forces, as our correspondent could not know the victims names.

In another hand, the residents of Al Nairab camp are complaining of the continuous power cut for several months, what led them to use generators which manage to replace the power and light the houses and the shops, but the problem of running the washing machines and refrigerators is still remain, since the generators capacity is too poor, The residents also suffer of the poor cell phone network and the internet cut.

Al Nosra front of the Syrian opposition forces in Damascus issued a decision to prevent smoking at Al Yarmouk Camp and in public, which outraged and anger some residents and even made them fighting with elements from the front while preventing them from smoking in the streets, which led to a number of wounded from both sides, It is worth mentioning that Al Nosra front "of al-Qaeda, is one of the most active armed groups inside the Yarmouk camp and it has headquarters inside it.

Meanwhile, an explosive bomb was placed in a car was parking near by Al Basil hospital at Izz Al Dein Al Qassamin the Yarmouk Camp yesterday, resulted in no injuries.



It is referred that this bomb is the fourth one during the past few days, while the first one exploded near Palestine square and the others exploded near Palestine Mosque.

A state of quietness prevailed Khan AL Sheih Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus city amid the continuous cut of the roads that link the camp with the adjacent areas except for Zakia-Khan AL Sheih road, while residents have to take Zakia road despite the risk. In terms of living aspect, the residents complain of the deterioration of the health services, since only one UNRWA clinic is working and only providing simple health services.

Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee rehabilitated a new well at Abdul Qader Al Husseini Park in Al Yarmouk Camp for being used in supporting the water manholes in the park. The project supervised by Palestine Charity Committee in the frame of the relief agencies trial to alleviate the impacts of water cut for 41 days respectively. Thus, the institutions and agencies inside the Yarmouk Camp are continuing the campaign of cleaning the streets and lanes of the camp under the slogan "Imatat AL Aza".

The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the **471** respectively in addition to the power cut for more than **554** days and the water cut for **41** days respectively. The number of the siege victims is **155** victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the **373** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the **342** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:***-The residents left the camp since **542** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - Almost **188** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:***- the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except the Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - economic crises continue specially the unemployment and the high prices.
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - the power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
