"Syrian Warplanes Target the Sides of Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus Suburb with Explosive Barrels"

Recent Updates

The Syrian warplanes raided the sides of Khan Al Shieh camp in the vicinity of Al Zohour Street near Al Salam highway, coincided with 6 explosive barrels that targeted the same area, while warplanes still hovering and raiding the area.

The regular army checkpoints are still closing all roads linking the camp with the capital Damascus, forcing the resident to take the dangerous sub-road Zakia-Khan Al Shieh to get to Damascus. This road has been frequently targeted with shells and heavy machine guns, as the AGPS documented 141 victims from the camp; most of them died due to shelling.



On the other hand, Palestinian activists launched a solidarity campaign through Facebook pages entitled 'Do Not Forget the Yarmouk'. According to the campaign's organizers, the campaign is aiming to reconsider the case of the Yarmouk camp and the rest of Palestinian camps in Syria under the frequent shelling and under the suffering of the besieged people.



Meanwhile, the activists criticized the official Arab, Palestinian, and International negligence towards the violations against those camps, in addition to the media blackout, especially the Palestinian media.

The organizers of the campaign called the displaced people of the Yarmouk camp and other camps to reconsider the Palestinian camps and to reestablish the social bonds with the besieged people in order to face their tragic situation, and to reconsider their dire living situation.

The Palestinian refugees in the Palestinian camps, especially in the Yarmouk camp, are suffering of the going war, victims, and the arrest campaigns against the Palestinian youth.

Meanwhile, the regular army and PFGC groups are still besieging the camp for 871 consecutive days, power still cuts for 941 days, water still cuts for 431 days, and the number of victims has risen to 184 victims.



The Syrian security forces continue detaining the Palestinian cameraman activist "Neraz Saed" who was arrested in Damascus last September.

According to activists, Neraz was arrested after receiving guarantees to get out to Damascus, while he was leaving the Yarmouk camp after receiving threats from "ISIS" which controls the camp since the beginning of last April.

"Neraz Saed" had won numerous awards for his artistic work that documented the stages of the siege on the Yarmouk refugee camp, most



notably the UNRWA Award for the best press image of "Three Kings," as well as the movie of "Letters from Yarmouk" which has won numerous international awards.

Civil Work Committees

A delegation from the Palestinian House at Netherlands visited a number of shelters that receive refugees from Syria, including "Budel" and "Weert" shelters, in addition to the newly established school in "Weert" center.



According to the Palestinian house, the delegation welcomed the newcomers, gets to know them, listened to them talking about the bitterness and the suffering of accessing to the Netherlands, they also listened to the problems they face now, and advised them how to overcome all their problems.

Netherlands are at the forefront of European countries of destination for refugees who fled the war in Syria to seek asylum.



Numbers and Statistics till 19/11/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 871 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 941 days, water was cut for 431 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 732 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 933 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 577 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
