“Lebanese General Security Separates some Palestinian Mothers of their Children at the Syrian Lebanese Border”

Lebanon

The Lebanese General Security prevented six Palestinian of Syria women from joining their children in Lebanon, after they prevent mothers, who joined their children to Syria to do high school exams, to return to Lebanon.

Yesterday morning, the Lebanese General Security allowed the entry of Palestinian of Syria students only, without their mothers.

It is worth mentioning that mothers refused the Public Security decision and they are still stranded at the Syrian-Lebanese border since yesterday morning until the time of preparing this report.

In the same context, a number of stranded women families launched appeals to each of: Maj. Gen. Abbas Ibrahim, Lebanese General Security and all concerned to intervene and allow the six women to enter Lebanon, and reunite with their families.



Recent Updates

Violent explosions rocked Dara'a camp southern Syria, yesterday, where heavy shelling targeted the surrounding areas of the camp. Meanwhile, the rest of the people in the camp are suffering of the absence of most of the basic services, because of the great destruction that hit its infrastructure because of the repeated bombardment and violent attacks on Dara'a camp. Hundreds of families were forced to flee from the Dara'a camp in order to save their lives.

On the other hand, the siege imposed on Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus still continues for more than ten months. The siege impacted Bakeries and most hospitals to stop working, completely, in addition to power outages since about a year.

In the same context, the old man Yassin Mufdi Abdullah Alian, 73 years, passed away, a day after his return to the camp where he had left for treatment in one of Damascus city hospitals. In Latakia, the suffering of Al Raml Camp people concentrated on both sides of economic and living conditions, where people are suffering of widespread unemployment, in addition to the high cost of living, high prices of food stuffs and rent houses.

Hungary

Rakan Hussein still continues hunger strike for the eighth day, respectively, where Rakan protests against the obstruction of Hungarian authorities to reunited with his children on the pretext that they do not recognize Syrian passports. Rakan changed the location of his hunger strike to the International Red Cross headquarter in Budapest.
