“Four Palestinian Victims and 400 days of the Yarmouk Camp Siege amid Separated Violent Clashes”



Yarmouk Camp

- Four Palestinian victims were killed, three of them due to torture.
- Sadness and worry are prevailed Khan Al Shaih camp after one day of its bombing by explosive barrels.
- The residents of Al Aedin camp in Homs live in a miserable humanitarian situation.
- The Algerian and Egyptian authorities detain Palestinians of Syria refugees.

Victims

Four Palestinians of Syria refugees were killed in Syria, three of them due to torture and the fourth due to wounds he attained in a previous bombing on the Yarmouk camp. The victims are Osama MAjed Faour from Khan Al Shaih camp and he was arrested for four months, Ahmed Sammour" Abu Satee" from Al Aedin camp in Homs and Mohammed Ali Baddawi the three of them were killed due to torture. Mohammed Fayeeg Ali died due to wounds that he attained.

Recent Updates

Three shells were dropped on Yarmouk camp, targeted the entrances of the camp near the Regular Army and the PFGC checkpoints. It is mentioned that the Regular army and the Public Front-General Command are imposing a strict siege on the Yarmouk camp since about 400 days.

It is referred that the residents of the Yarmouk lost 154 people because of siege and its sequences such as the lack of nourishment and medical care. Meanwhile, violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk camp yesterday between the Armed Brigades, the Regular Army and the PFGC near the Palestine street amid news about victims from both sides.

A state of Sadness and Worry prevailed Khan Al Shaih camp in Damascus city yesterday due to the bombing by explosive barrels which



resulted in victims and dozens of wounded in addition to the huge damage in civilian houses. In general, the camp residents suffer from frequent bombing which targets their camp and the surrounding areas.

In Al Aedin camp in Homs, the residents complain of economic crises due to the security situation, where the checkpoints of the Regular Army separate the camp of its surrounding and the checkpoints are centralized on its entrances in addition to the security tension in the surrounding areas. The security situation in the camp led to the spread of unemployment where people only depend on the food aids that they receive once in a while.

Egypt

The Egyptian authorities continue to detain two Palestinians of Syria refugees for the ninth day respectively. The authorities arrested 15 Palestinians of Syria refugees who went to Gaza for several months and then got out to Egypt because of the Israeli aggression that the Gaza Strip is exposed to. The 15 refugees were arrested in Cairo Airport and they were given the choice to return back to Gaza or to be deported to Syria. The Authorities deported 13 refugees to Syria amid fears to deport the rest of them regarding the threat to their life. The refugee Hamza Easa and Yousif Yousif stayed in Egypt. It is mentioned that about 1000 people, about 246 Palestinians of Syria and Syrian families crossed to the Gaza Strip under the rule of Egyptian President "Mohammed Morsi". The refugees are distributed to all cities and camps of the Gaza Strip.



Algeria

The Algerian authorities continue to detain the Palestinian Syrian young man Fadi Sabbagh for the second day in Algeria airport. Fadi got out of the Yarmouk camp to flee from the bombardment and siege to Lebanon and from Lebanon to Algeria. Till this moment, there is no information about his place or the conditions of his detaining. It is mentioned that the Algerian authorities arrested 3 Palestinians of Syria refugees on charge of entering Algeria with fake passports.
