“A Palestinian Refugee Died Due to Torture.... Activists Launch a Campaign titled “The Yarmouk Camp is Thirsty, the Yarmouk Camp calls: We Want to Live”



- Bombing on the northern parts of Khan Al Sheih camp.
- The Jermana camp residents live in a worry state due to the security situation deterioration in the surrounding areas.
- The continuance of closing the Qudseyya area in Damascus city which contains hundreds of families for the fifth day respectively.

Recent Updates

Activists launch a media Campaign titled “The Yarmouk Camp is Thirsty, The Yarmouk Camp calls: we want to live” on the social media pages “Facebook” to highlight the disastrous impacts that will result due to the water cut on the Yarmouk camp and to call to break the Yarmouk siege that is imposed by the Regular Army and the PFGC since 427 days.

Mortar shells targeted Al Reeja Suare in the Yarmouk camp and the Street of Al- forn Al -Aali coincided with clashes between the militant groups inside the camp with the Regular army and the PFGC. On the other hand, the UNRWA resumed the distribution of food baskets on the Yarmouk residents who suffer of water cut for the eleventh day respectively and the cut of land line, mobile line and internet services. The residents also complain of the power cut for more than a year.

On a different context, the northern parts of Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees were exposed to bombing with explosive barrels that



resulted in only material damages. The frequent closures of the roads that connect the camp with the city center continue due to the frequent clashes in those areas. The Initiative of “Rad Fei'l”, which was organized by the Hemma Voluntary Group in Khan Al Sheih camp, continues for the ninth day to clean the garbage and erasing the mounds from the inside streets of the camp.

Sounds of heavy clashes and explosions were heard in Jermana camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus city. The sounds were due to bombing on Al Maleeha area that surrounds the camp and Jermana area. The residents of Jermana camp suffer of the high prices of food supplies and the rent houses. It is refereed that the camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families that were displaced from their camps due to the bombing and the siege.

In Qudseyya town in Damascus city, which contains 6000 Palestinian families most of them are from the Yarmouk camp, the Regular army still closes the roads that connect Qudseyya with Damascus center for the fifth day respectively, which causes a severe shortage of bread and food supplies. In Al Nairab camp, the Islamic Jihad of Palestine organized in the Education center in Al Nairab camp Al Bonyan Al Marous festival” Gaza Victory is the Way to Jerusalem” . The excellent students of secondary and elementary schools were honored in the festival of Al Bonyan Al Marsous.



Greece

A Group of the Palestinians of Syria refugees, who were arrested by the Greek Authorities under the pretext of illegal immigration in the military Samos Island, started a hunger strike protesting on their bad humanitarian situation and called to be released and solving their crisis.

Turkey

The refugees of Kls shelter center in Turkey lived a fear state due to the bombing that targeted the border areas inside Syria that surround the camp and the heavy Explosion sounds. It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinians of Syria families were displaced to Turkey because their camps were exposed to bombing and siege, where most of them are suffering of economic and legal problems and most of them entered Turkey by illegal ways because the Turkish embassy in Lebanon refused to give them visas to the Turkish lands without showing the reasons.

Lebanon

A number of Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon organized a sit-in in front of the UNRWA Service Director offices in Al Baddawi camp in Tripoli and Ein El Helwa camp in Sidon to protest on the last decisions of UNRWA which cut the financial aids on hundreds of the Palestinians of Syria families in Lebanon, the decision will increase the living crises that



they suffer of. The protestors condemn the UNRWA decisions and considered it as step for the UNRWA to shirk the responsibility towards the refugees. In Ein El Helwa camp, the protestors went to the office of the UNRWA Social Office and closed the office and threatened of other escalating steps if UNRWA didn't return back of its decision.
