"Explosive Barrels Target Khan Al Shieh Camp and the Regular Army Tightens Procedures at the Entrances and Exits of Al Aedein Camp in Hama"

Recent Updates

Syrian warplanes dropped two explosive barrels on the farms surrounding Khan Al Shieh camp, which provoked a state of anxiety among residents due to targeting the vicinity of the camp and for fear of being targeted.

The camp and its vicinity are targeted with explosive barrels and mortar shells, which resulted in victims and wounded among civilians and destruction in homes.



The AGPS documented 141 victims mostly died by shelling, while the regular army checkpoints are continuing to close all connecting roads between the camp and the center of the capital Damascus, forcing residents to take the dangerous road of (Khan Al Shieh - Zakya) in order to reach to Damascus, where the road is targeting frequently with shells and heavy machine guns.

Furthermore, residents of Al Aedein camp in Hama live in great suffering because of strict security cordon imposed by the regular army at the



entrances and exits of the camp, as well as the raids and arrests campaigns carried out by the regular army between now and then.

In terms of the economic aspect, residents are complaining of widespread unemployment due to the tense security situation, while most of them lost work and become completely dependent on relief aid that is distributed between now and then.

The camp receives a large number of displaced families from various camps and cities of Damascus, Aleppo, Idlib, Hama suburb, Deirez-Zor, Raqqa, Daraa, and Latakia.

In the city of Aleppo, the 47-year-Palestinian refugee "Khaled NajiAl-Naji" was injured after a shell landed on the road between the city of Aleppo and Nairab camp, during his return to the camp.



The AGPS correspondent stated that the only way between the Neirab camp and the city of Aleppo has been closed as a result of clashes, which broke out in Ramouseh and Amiriya districts, and the subsequent shelling and sniping of the road, which resulted in the detention of a number of people in that region.

The camp is witnessing a state of instability and unsafety because of the tension security situation in the adjacent areas, because of the ongoing fighting between the regular army and armed opposition groups.

The AGPS documented 127 victims from Neirab camp who died since the start of war events in Syria.



Lebanon

Media sources said that the Lebanese authorities have allowed the 18-year-Palestinian Syrian female student "Duha Alyan, to enter entering Lebanese territory on Tuesday, after waiting for about 18 hours at Al-Masnaa checkpoint since late Monday. The student was returning after performing the general information test of the high school in Damascus.



These sources added that great efforts were made by the follow-up committee of displaced Palestinians from Syria to Lebanon to enter the student Alian, and were recently paid off, despite the fact that public security prevents her entry to Lebanon for 5 years after midnight yesterday.

The Lebanese authorities have prevented Palestinians from entering their territory Syria since May 2014, while the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon is estimated to 45,000 refugees who fled from the furnace of the Syrian war.



Release

The Syrian security forces released the official of the PRCS Volunteers in Homs branch, Mr. Khaled Zaid 'Abu Jamal', after being detained for about seven months. The Syrian security forces arrested him at the Syrian-Lebanese border under unknown charges. He is one of the most important workers at voluntary domain at Al Aedein camp in Homs.



It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented the names of 180 Palestinian prisoners from Al Aedein camp in Homs, while the documented toll of the Palestinian detainees in the Syrian prisons is 988 detainees; the Syrian security reticent about their fate and places of detention.

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team confirmed that the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees who have taken refuge in Europe from 2011 until June 2015 amounted to (36450) refugees, based on the UNHCR statistics and reports.



In details, nearly (2465) Palestinian Syrian refugees had reached Europe during 2011, while (3513) refugees have arrived during 2012, while the number rose to (9620) refugees in 2013, and continued to rise in 2014 to reach (13902) refugees, based on the UNHCR statistics.

Figures indicate that (6950) Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived to Europe during the first half of 2015.

It is noteworthy that most Palestinian Syrian refugees who have arrived in Europe have boarded "boats of death" risking their lives and the lives of their children, searching for safety and stability, especially after most countries around the world prevented their entry into its territory.

Numbers and Statistics till 20/10/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 841 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 911 days, water was cut for 401 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 702 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 903 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 547 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
