## **Detainees Women**

Syrian Security Forces continue arresting dozens of Palestinian refugee women, and secrecy about their fate and their names, as well as their families for fear of their lives, and hoping of their release. The AGPS documentation team confirmed that the number of Palestinian detainee women in the Syrian regime's prisons since the beginning of the war in Syria and until the moment of preparing this report has reached 36 Palestinian women.

The detained women were arrested at the existing checkpoints on gates and entrances of the camps and towns, as the group clarified that the indications pointed out that the numbers of women who have been subjected to arrest by the conflict parties is greater than this number, but it is in secrecy for private reasons related to those cases, while the group has documented the names of many of them with date and circumstances of their arrest.

It is noteworthy that the total toll of AGPS statistics about the Palestinian refugees, and the detainees in the Syrian prisons has reached 868 detainees, their fate is still unknown.

## **Victims**

The Palestinian refugee woman, "Ghadir Abu Dhais" died due to wounded she attained as a result of the fall of shell on her at Al Malki





neighborhood in Damascus, she is from Al Nairab camp, and lives in Damascus

The Palestinian refugee "Mohamed Mahmoud Masharqah," 32 years from the city of Hebron, died under torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, after being detained for more than 7 years. His family was informed about his death by a Palestinian detainee who was released.

It is noteworthy that the Masharqah had been arrested in the Syrian Golan in 2008, where he was escaping the Israeli occupation chase after his release in exchange deal between Hezbollah and the Israeli occupation.

### **Recent Updates**

Number of missiles and rockets targeted Yarmouk camp in Damascus yesterday causing only material damages, coincided with renewed clashes between ISIS alongside Al Nusra Front and the Palestinian armed groups, resulted in no progress for both parties, where ISIS still controls about 60% of the camp, while the regular army and armed groups control about 40%.

In a related context, the AGPS reporter in Damascus western suburb reported news about the closure of Khan Al Shieh road because of the outbreak of violent clashes between the regular army and the armed groups of the Syrian opposition at Salam Street near the camp, accompanied by bombing that targeted the vicinity of Al Salam Highway and the outbreak of fires in some of those areas. Residents of the camp suffered from panic and anticipation state after the Shilka clashes



approached to their homes that were damaged by it, and for fear of repeating the bombing of the camp with explosive barrels, rockets, and mortars.

Al Nairab camp in Aleppo suffers from the migration of Palestinian families and youth as a result of the deteriorated security and living conditions, headed for Turkey and European countries, where it was noted recently, departure of a large number of young men to Turkey trying to gain access to the European asylum countries.

In Turkey, many young people and families waiting for ways to deliver them to reach the European mainland through legitimate and illegitimate ways, and because of the prosecution of the Syrian security services and the affiliated group Al Quds Brigade who force them to join the PLA. As well as the security tightening about the youth movement in and outside the camp, and the arrest of the security services for many of them.

On the other hand, sounds of clashes were heard yesterday afternoon at the vicinity of Khan Dannoun camp in Damascus suburb, resulted in a state of tension in the ranks of people. It was mentioned that the camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from their camps because of the shelling and siege.

## **UNRWA**

UNRWA announced that it will distribute financial assistance to the Palestinian refugees in Syria, as it confirmed in a statement published on its page on Facebook, that the only beneficiaries of this aid are the people who are on Syrian territory, which means travelers, immigrants, and absentee will be prevented of such assistance.

UNRWA indicated that it will begin the distribution of financial assistance, which worth 16 thousand Syrian pounds for those who do not get rations, and 24 thousand Syrian pounds for those who gets subsistence. To the small families first at a rate of 40 families a day, and noted that when the presence of the family will ensure the absence or travel a individuals through personal proof for all the family, and said "UNRWA" The installation of families information, must be in their

## Lebanon

A delegation of Palestinians of Syria Teachers LEague headed by YounisAl Masri, the head of the founding committee, met with the Educational Institutions Network in Lebanon at the administration headquarters in Beirut. They explained the objectives of assembly, means adopted by the constituent body to achieve, and the most important activities carried out by the assembly through the previous period, most notably was the intensive courses for students of basic education.

At the end of the visit, coordination between the two parties was agreed to invest all abilities and energies in the achievements and services for students and teachers.





### Numbers and Statistics till 18/5/2015

- At least **27933** Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- **The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **691** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **761** days, water was cut for **251** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to **177** victims.
- **80,000** Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including **10,687** refugees in Jordan, **51,300** in Lebanon and **6,000** refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- **Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **573** days respectively.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **553** days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for **755** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 398 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- **Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
