Victims

Two Palestinians brothers, Ghassn and Baraa Ayman Al Zreeki, were killed in Daraa due to explosive barrels bombing of Sidon town in Daraa. It is referred that Al Zreeki family and hundreds of families left Daraa camp because of the Syrian warplanes shells and the continuous sniping operations.

Wael Abu Zahra from Khan Al Sheih died after he was kidnapped by an opposition Syrian military group. Khalid Ali Hamad Al Misawi, 50 years old, from Daraa camp was killed by shootings from the Regular Army Checkpoint between Daraa and Al Muzareeb town. Ayman Mohammed Subheya from Al Aedin camp died under torture in the Syrian Prisons.

Recent Update

Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city was exposed to bombings and shells which targeted its eastern street near the public road, leaving just material damages. Wael Abu Zahra died after he was kidnapped from an opposition Syrian military group. Mohamed and Abu Erfan Khunfees were released. A calm state prevailed Khan Al Sheih camp after the arrest of three youth from the camp yesterday.



The effects of bombing on Khan Al Sheih refugee camp

An anger and tension state was spread amongst the Yarmouk camp people due to the frequent clashes several days ago between militants and Daesh . The clashes ended with associations and arrests like the arrest of Khalil Al Zaghmout, Abu Hashem, one of the military brigade's officer in the camp by Al Nusra Front. Abu Hamam, a member of the military council for the Environs of Jerusalem brigades in the Yarmouk camp, insured that, on a radio interview, the arrest of Abu Hashem came under security reasons and the problem will be solved in several days.

Few days ago, the Yarmouk camp witnessed assault and battery actions by military groups from out of the camp on the Colonel Khalid Al Hasan, the head of the Dissenter Libration Palestine Army. Abu Al Khair Al



Khatib was assassinated by Daash in a shot in his head near Palestine mosque.

In terms of health, the number of people infected with Typhoid in the Yarmouk camp is more than 110 people, according to a declaration from one of the doctors to the Action Group inside the camp. In the same context, the Palestine hospital received a quantity of Typhoid medicine from UNRWA and the Public Commission for the Palestinian Refugees inside the Yarmouk camp which is besieged for a year.

A point of Typhoid vaccination was established in the Yarmouk camp in cooperation with Al Nour Society for Relief and Development, Palestinian Progressive Youth Organization and Jafra Organization in the place of food baskets delivery point in Al Reeja square.

A doctor from the Yarmouk camp referred that the spread of typhoid is due to depending on contaminated water wells and the vegetables from Yelda polluted lands. The doctor warned from the raise in the rate of death people in the absence of treatment and the siege.

*Typhoid fever is one of the infectious diseases known since ancient times, which an epidemic disease is caused by a bacterium, scientifically called *Salmonella typhi*. The Palestine hospital has received remains of an unknown corpse where the corpse was completely decomposed and without a skull. The specialists expected that the death was a year ago.*

In the southern of Syria, Dara'a camp and its vicinity are still exposed to explosive barrels bombing by the Syrian warplanes frequently few days ago. On 15th July 2014, 9 victims were killed by explosive barrels bombardment in addition to tens of injured people in the camp and its vicinity. The bombing resulted in mass destruction in houses of people on the heads of its residents which prompted a big number of families to leave the camp to the surrounding areas. The remained people are complaining of the running out of food and medicine materials and the continuance of the water and power cut since about three weeks and the high prices of fuel.

Arrests

The Syrian Security arrested the Palestinian refugees, Hitham Belani, 50 years old, and his brother Jameel Belani on Al Hamdaneya checkpoint in Aleppo. The Action Group referred that the number of detainees and kidnapped people is 718 Palestinian refugees since the beginning of the Syrian ongoing conflict.

Civil Work Committees

Under the slogan of "Lamset Hanan" the Palestine Charity Committee in the Yarmouk camp carried out a collective Iftar for the Orphans and their families to alleviate their suffering and to know their needs. This is part of a project of orphans sponsorship implemented by the body for years.

On the other hand the Department of Youth and volunteers at the Palestinian Red Crescent training campaign on personal hygiene and healthy behavior proper to the children of the camp with the aim of prevention of these diseases and the dissemination of health awareness among the residents of the camp to mitigate the risk of these diseases.

In a related context, the Committee of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon at Sidon city carried out a free haircut in Zein building



compound which houses a number of families of Palestinians and Syrians coming from Syria to Lebanon.

It is noteworthy that the largest percentage of Palestinian Syrian families who fled from the hell of war in Syria to Lebanon which estimated of 51 thousand people, have resorted to the Sidon area, where the rate was 34.36%, nearly 26% of them resident in Ain al-Hilweh, an average of 2091 family according to UNRWA statistics.
