*Activists confirmed to the AGPS that the child Osama Diab Majzoub drowned in the Mediterranean while trying to reach Europe, while the AGPS could not get other details yet.*

*It is worth mentioning that the Turkish media published yesterday news of the sinking of 6 refugees coming from Syria, while trying to reach Europe.*

### ***Recent Updates***

*According to the AGPS correspondent, Al Nusra Front in the north of Syria arrested two Palestinians working with the pro-Syrian regime Popular Committees in Aleppo.*

*Our correspondent pointed out that the two detainees are Mohammed Asad and Hamouda Hourani, from Nairab camp in Aleppo, while Nusra announced its intention to transfer them to its legal Court.*



*Meanwhile, unconfirmed news reported that Al-Nusra Front drag the two detainees to the north of Syria, then they fled to Turkey.*

*On the other hand, a mortar shell targeted Bear Sabea School at Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, which resulted in one injury and material damage in the place.*



#### ***Khan Al Shieh camp***

*Violent clashes renewed between groups affiliated to the Syrian regular army and armed opposition, in the vicinity of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, especially at Darousha axes, coincided with bombing that targeted different areas of the camp.*

*In a related context, our correspondent confirmed that heavy machine guns targeted (Zakia, Khan Al Shieh) road, which is the only way remained for residents to the capital Damascus.*

*In South of Syria, Syrian security forces arrested a group of residents from Muzeireeb compound in the Lajat area between the provinces of Daraa and Sweida southern Syria, 50 kilometers south of Damascus; some of them were recognized, they are: them young, Khaled Mohsen*



*Kharroubi and Fayez Abdel Raouf, while residents reticent about their detained relatives fearing for their lives.*

*It is noteworthy that Lajat area is a haven for every fugitive or wanted; the only corridor for the people in southern region and link them to the Syrian North.*

*Hundreds of refugees who wish to enter Turkey went through Lajat area, for the fact that all roads linking between southern of Syria and the capital either closed or have checkpoints of Syrian security and army.*

*The AGPS documented 46 Palestinian refugee detainees from Daraa province, their fate is still unknown.*

*In a related context, the Syrian security forces arrested the refugee, Khaled Azzam in his sixties, from Nairab camp in Aleppo, during his return to the camp coming from Latakia.*



### ***Numbers and Statistics till 20/8/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 779 days respectively. In addition, power*

*cuts continued for more than 849 days, water was cut for 339 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.*

- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 641 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 842 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 486 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
