"Assassinating a Member of Al-Nusra Front in Al-Yarmouk Camp"



- Targeting Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road and warnings from crossing it.

RECENT UPDATES

AGPS received reports regarding assassinating "Husam Ammoura" nicknamed "Abu Oday" as he was targeted by bombing device in Al-Yarmouk Camp which killed him and injured two others.

Ammoura was the head of the "Complaining Centre" and member of the "Relief Office" inside Al-Yarmouk Camp, and member of "Al-Nusra Front" as well.



It is noteworthy that there are lot of conflicts and "unsettled accounts" between the armed opposition groups, the last incident was assassinating the commander or Amir of "Al-Nusra Front" in Al-Yarmouk "Abu Yousuf Al-Darawi" by exploding an explosive device near "Al-Million Butcher" inside Al-Yarmouk camp.

Turning to western Damascus Suburb, many activists and people from Khan Eshieh Camp warned, via facebook pages, of crossing Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road since it is being targeted frequently by heavy submachine guns.



Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road considered to be the last open artery to feed the besieged camp, most of the camp's residents are obliged to pass through that road in spite of the high risk. People were frequently targeted while passing that road even they nicknamed it as "The Death Road". It is noteworthy that the AGPS has documented 141 victims from Khan Eshieh camp since the beginning of the war, many of them were killed in that particular road.



In a different context, the Syrian Security forces released the refugee "Tareq Hasan Basyouni" after six months of arrest from Aideen camp in Home City where he used to live, the AGPS refers that 180 other arrestees from the same camp are still unaccounted for until now.

While in South of Syria, in Muziereeb town, the Palestinian refugee "Anas Ali Qasim" 38-years-old was arrested at regime's checkpoint as he worked as a minibus driver.

The AGPS mentions that it managed to document 15 arrestees from Al-Muzireeb town in Daraa, including one woman still unaccounted for, while it is believed that the real number could be much more than that.



CIVIL SOCIETY WORKS

As part of "Winter Warmth Project" the "Palestine Charity Association" has distributed olive dregs as a heating fuel to needy people in Alajami area in Daraa.

Meanwhile, the volunteers' team of the same association was providing drinking water to displaced families from Al-Yarmouk to nearby towns.

Moreover, the association provides simple medical care for burns and injuries in emergency cases.

It is important to mention that most of the relief foundations inside Al-Yarmouk camp had been suspended and most of the activists had been threatened and forced to leave or stop their works since ISIS broke into the camp last April.

LEBANON

UNRWA has filled the ATM cards of the Palestinian-Syrians in Lebanon, the amount of 60,000LL which equals \$40 was paid as winter clothing cost presented from Qatari Red Crescent and Uniqlo Company via the Japanese Campaign for Children of Palestine.

Previously, the UNRWA had pad the first payment of winter aid presented from British Oxfam and the US Government which equals \$27 per person, and announced that the second payment will be next January.

In a different context, the "Palestinian-Syrians in Lebanon Committee" distributed winter clothing and shoes to selected families of orphans in



Lebanon, also, distributed copies of Holy Quran in the anniversary of Prophet's birth PBUH.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 21 December 2015

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 903 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 973 days, water cut for 463 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims .*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 764 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 965 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 609 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Homs and Aedein Hamma: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
