The arrested refugees in Egypt

- Two injuries due to the bombing of AL Nairab camp in Aleppo.
- Sporadic clashes in the Yarmouk camp and the water cut is continuing for the 13th day respectively.
- Activists and dignitaries of Sbeina camp renew their calls to return back to their camp.
- Stifling living crises to the residence of Daraa camp due to the deteriorating security situation in Syria.

Recent Updates

Bombing and two shells were dropped on Al Nairab camp in Aleppo north of Syria, the first shell targeted the main entrance and the second one hit a house to Abu Merwan Al Naji and resulted in the injury of Ahmed Ali Al Khatib and ALaa AL Sheikh Houd. This bombing came in light of the continuation of the instable state of the residents as a result of the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas.

Meanwhile, sporadic clashes broke out in the Yarmouk camp south of the Syrian capital Damascus at the crossing of Yarmouk municipality in Palestine Street, coincided with heavy explosion sounds resulted in the exchange of shelling between armed groups inside the camp and the Regular Army alongside with the PFGC.

The water crises is still continuous for the 13th day respectively in the Yarmouk camp which exacerbated the crisis experienced by the residents because of the continued siege imposed on the camp for more than "429" days respectively. In addition to the crisis of power cut and lack of fuel and cooking gas for more than a year.

On the other hand, the Action Group declared that the number of Palestinian Syrian victims, who were killed in Sbeina camp in Damascus city since the beginning of the Syrian events until the end of August 2014, reached 58 people, according to the documented statistics done by the Documentation team in the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria.

For their part, a number of activists and dignitaries from Sbeineh camp demanded to return to their camp, and spare them the pain of displacement and homelessness and the ravages of the living and economic crisis, especially since the army had to control Sbeineh camp since about eleven months. In the meantime, warned calm prevailed lanes and alleys of Daraa camp southern Syria, coincided with strong explosions caused by the bombing of the surrounding areas.

In terms of humanitarian level, the residents suffer of suffocating living crises because of the deteriorating security situation in Syria in general and the camp, in particular, which led to depletion of most food, vegetables and flour. On the other hand, people complain of a severe shortage of medicines, supplies, and medical staff and the continuing disruption of infrastructure services such as water, electricity and communications for long periods.

In another context, explosive barrels targeted the surrounding areas of Khan AL Sheih camp in Damascus city meanwhile, the roads that connect the camp and the city center is still frequently close due to its exposure to the sniping and shelling and repeated clashes.

As in AL Sayeda Zainab camp, the rest of the residents suffer from a lack of food, medical supplies and heating, and the continued power, communications and landlines cut for hours and long periods.

Releas

The Syrian Security released Khaldeyya Ahmed from the Khan Al Shaih camp yesterday. Omar Ghannam from Al Aedin camp in Homs was also released after being arrested for 8 hours.

Egypt

The Egyptian Security arrested 200 Palestinians of Syria and Syrian refugees and detained them in a sports center in Alexandria because they were trying to reach Europe through the sea. The Egyptian security raided those families in a place near the Alexandria beach and arrested them in the charge of trying to immigrate illegally. It is mentioned that this was not the first time that the Egyptian authorities arrest Palestinians of Syria families and detaining them in difficult conditions for long periods.
