"Two Palestinian Refugees Dies in Syria,, Two Brothers from Al Aedin Camp in Homs are Missing"

Victims

The Palestinian refugee Abdulla Ahmed Abdulla 52 years old died and four people were injured due to a shell including a father and his son while they were filling water from the drinking water distribution point in Al Tadamun neighborhood besides the Yarmouk camp. He is one of Right of Return Committee activists at Yarmouk camp and a member of the Democratic Front (DFLP).



Moreover, the Palestinian refugee Moyad Ahmed Mohammed from Khan Al Sheih camp died due to torture in the Syrian prisons after being arrested for about 9 months while going to work.

Recent Updates

The Yarmouk residents suffering is increasing due to the continuation of water and electricity cut because of the continuous siege by the Regular Army the PFGC, which prompted the residents to risk their lives to go to the surrounding areas on foot for securing drinking water for their



families and children. In the same context, The Palestinian refugee Abdulla Ahmed Abdulla 52 years old was shot with four people including a father and his son due to a shell while they were filling water from the drinking water distribution point in Al Tadamun neighborhood besides the Yarmouk camp.

Jafr Organization entered new humanitarian aid within its campaign of "For the Yarmouk 6" which will be distributed to displaced Yarmouk residents at Yelda , Bebla and bait Sahem towns, where it will include food and hygiene parcels in addition to water disinfection pills. On the other hand, the Palestine Pharmacy in Palestine Charity Commission continues to present the medical prescriptions to Yarmouk camp where it daily distributes about 90 free medical prescriptions. The Palestine Charity continues to fill water for the displaced Yarmouk residents at Yelda and Bebla towns.



In Damascus Suburb, UNRWA started to distribute the food aid to the residents of Khan Danoun in Damascus Suburb, where the residents complain of a clear relief vacuum with the difficult economic situations they live. The Relief vacuum is due to the unavailability of charity organizations or the local committees inside the camp due to the security



retractions by the Regime forces and the arrest campaigns that affected a lot of relief activists in the camp, which prompted the committees to close their doors to save their souls. The camps residents are still considered the poorest amongst the other Palestinian camps in Syria and they depend on the financial and relief aid that is presented by the UNRWA once in a while.



The Palestinian Refugee Ahmed Ghazi from Khan Al Sheih camp was arrested by the members of Al Meshihem checkpoint of the Syrian regime at Kwekeb town in Damascus Suburb. On 16 September 2015, the Syrian Security released three people from Khan Al Sheih camp including a father and his son and a woman. They are; Jamal S'oud, Khalid Jamal S'oud by the members of Al Somareyya checkpoint of the Syrian regime in Al Mazza area in Damascus. As well as it released the refugee woman Sabreyya Yousif after being arrested for more than two months. It is referred that the AGPS documented 85 detainees from the camp's residents in the Syrian prisons.

In a different context, the two brothers Raed and Akram Husni Derbas were missed on 15-9-2015 during their travel out of Syrian to Europe and



there is no information about them till the moment. They are from the residents of Al Aedin camp and originally from Al Tera area in Hifa in Palestine.

Lebanon

The Lebanese General Security is restricting the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon under the pretext of expired residencies. The AGPS correspondent was able to contact one of the detained refugees in Al Hesba prison at Sidon south of Lebanon. The refugee insured that he is detained with 10 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Al Hesba prison since about two weeks in charges of residencies. The detained refugees appealed UNRWA, PLO, and Human Rights Organizations to release them, settle their legal situation and treat them as Syrian refugees.

It is referred that the Lebanese's Government deal with the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon as tourists, they are 45000 refugees, which extinguishes their right from the Lebanese country. The Lebanese government specially the Lebanese General Security witnesses unstable policies towards the displaced Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon, sometimes they issue a decision of renewing the residencies for two or three months and the refugee applies and when he get it he finds it about to expire. Moreover, the Government doesn't allow the Displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon to work in its territories.



Malaysia

For the Seventh day respectively, the Palestinian refugee Ibrahim Abu Kharj continues hunger strike protesting on his detention by the Malaysian authorities for 13 days respectively at Kuala Lumpur Airport and preventing him to enter its lands after he left it trying to resort to Europe before he got arrested by the Cambodian Police and returned back to Malaysia. It is referred that dozens of Palestinian Syrian refugees suffer from the difficulty to get a legal Malaysian residency due to the Malaysian strict residency procedures.



Numbers and Statistics till 21/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 811 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 881 days, water was cut for 371 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.

- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 673 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 874 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 518 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
