### *"By Orders from the Syrian Regime; Transferring Units of PLA towards Al-Shiekh Miskeen Hot Battlefield"*

- Two drowning incidents kill 42 immigrants most of them are women and children.

## ***VICTIMS***

The Palestinian refugee "Nizar Mahmoud Awad" from Al-Yarmouk Camp, member of the Fourth Squad of the Republican Guard, was killed during clashes with the armed opposition in Darayya City in Damascus Suburb. While the Palestinian refugee "Jihad Mohammad Ahmad Ali" from Al-Sayyida Zaynab Camp was killed in other place due to the ongoing war.



## ***UPDATES***

Special sources assured to the AGPS that, units from the Palestine Liberation Army have been transferred towards Al-Shiekh Miskeen Town to fight alongside with the Regime against the opposition forces in town considered as one of the hottest battlefronts in Daraa Province.

The Sources confirmed that this order has been made by the Syrian Regime Army, whereas the leadership of PLA implemented it immediately despite of the huge wave of criticism and condemnation that had been launched previously against recruiting Palestinian youngsters and using them in the Assad's Regime battles.



It should be noted that the military service is obligatory by law to each male exceeded 18 years old, this law pushed hundreds of refugees to deliberately failure of conscript and to hide or flee because of refusing to fight alongside with the regime.

In a different topic, the Palestinian-Syrians displaced to Lebanon participated, yesterday, in a mass demonstration against the cuts of UNRWA's health care aid, held in front of the agency's head office in Beirut.

The protestors demanded the UNRWA to retreat from its recent decisions which could cause server deterioration in health sector of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon holding the agency full responsibility about that.





It should be mentioned that 42,000 Palestinian refugee escaped the war to Lebanon.

Moving to Greece, 42 immigrants from Syria died in two drowning incidents in the Aegean Sea while trying to arrive to the Greek islands on their way to Western Europe countries.

The first incident took place off Kalymnos' Island coast, 34 immigrants died including 11 children after their boat flipped over in water, while 8 others died in the second incident close to Farmakonisi Island. 26 immigrants were rescued, according to rescue teams which mentioned that around 100 migrants were onboard and the rescue operations did not stop yet in order to find more survivors.



### ***Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 22 January 2016***

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command), continued for 923 days

respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1012 days, water cut for 501 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 185 victims .

- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 807 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1000 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 661 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.
