"At Least 20 Palestinians Were Killed in Al-Sayeda Zeinab Bombings in Damascus Countryside"

RECENT UPDATES

According to the AGPS' reporter in Al-Sayeda Zeinab camp; the number of Palestinian refugees who have died as a result of bombings hit the camp, the day before yesterday, has reached 20 victims, including three children, 10 women and 7 men, pointing out that the total deaths of Palestinian refugees is expected to increase, the victims are as following:

The child "Mohammed Ayman Saleh" , "Qais Mohammed Isa", "Habib Ibrahim Mahmoud Hassan", the woman "Um Moataz Mhawesh", "Amna Hamad Deeb Lafy", "Nawal Mohammed Deeb", "Aisha Mahmud", "Raghad Ahmad", "Dima Mohammed", "Samar Kamel Ibrahim", "Kauthar Kamel Ibrahim", "Islam Mohammed Mohammed", "Mohamed Ibrahim Bakr", "Yasser Jihad Rhban", "Ali Mur'ee Abdullah", "Hakam Mahmoud Saleem", "Mohammed Mahmoud Al-Marei" "Nasr Ahmed Hammoud" and "Haitham Mohammed Suleiman" who is the military director of the "Al-Nidal Front" or "Palestinian Popular Struggle Front" in Al-Sayeda Zeinab camp.



With regard to injuries, "Khaled Mahmoud Khamis" and "Saleh Raja Al Fazaa" were recognised.



Several explosions hit Al-Sayeda Zeinab district in Damascus Countryside the day before yesterday claimed the lives of more than 80 persons and 170 wounded, meanwhile, the rescue operations continued until late time yesterday.

The area and the Palestinian refugee camp adjacent to the location of the explosion are under Syrian security control and its allied Palestinian groups led by the PFLP-GC, Fatah Al-Intifada and the Al-Nidal Front.

In a different context, Aleppo's main road through Khanasser was blocked yesterday, this road links the city of Aleppo with Hama and Damascus Cities, and provides goods and various materials to Aleppo and Al-Nayrab camp, the road closed after violent clashes between the regime's army and groups loyal to it on one hand and the armed opposition groups on the Other hand, during which the nearby village of "Rasm Alnakel" was seized as well.



Residents of Al-Neirab camp expressed their great concern about the results of cutting the road and stopping the entry of goods, that could cause a new crisis and raise the prices, which consequently will increase the burdens on Palestinian refugees in Aleppo and Al Nairab camp.



As a reminder, the camp is witnessing a state of instability and insecurity due to the tension and clashes in the adjacent areas. The position of Al-Nayrab camp next to the military airport turned it into a strategic location for both parties in conflict, therefore it has been subjected many times previously to bombing and shooting and clashes that caused deaths among civilians.

In southern Damascus; the rest of the residents of Al-Yarmouk camp complain of continuing water cut since (532) days, which is forcing them to go to the neighboring areas in order to get a few liters of drinking water. Activist reported that the residents depend, almost completely, on artesian wells despite the fact that most of them are contaminated with dirt and sediment, which led to the spread of many diseases, including diseases related to kidneys and public hygiene.

The Syrian authorities stopped providing running water to the camp through its network since 9 September 2014, causing aggravation of water crises and sanitation.

Services Section of "Jafra Foundation for Relief and Development" continues cleaning up the lanes and streets inhabited by people of Al-Yarmouk refugee camp in the nearby areas, this comes as part of the relief efforts to keep the wastes away from people's houses to curb the spread of epidemics and diseases.

In the meantime, Syrian regime still arresting the Palestinian young man, "Adel Adib Diab" 23-years-old since 24 March 2014. Diab was arrested while leaving the old city of Homs as part of the settlement deal that took place in the city between the regime forces and opposition groups in



2014, where he was taken to Andalusia School in Homs and then to an unknown destination and didn't get any information about him after that.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 22 February 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 982 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1044 days, water cut for 532 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 838 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1031 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 692 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
