Recent Updates

News were reported from Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees about that a delegation headed by the mayor of Al Kaswa municipality representing the Syrian regime inside the camp besides some Palestinian and Syrian figures from Khan AL Sheih committee and the Palestine charity committee looked at the situation of the refugees in light of what they are exposed to such as the semi complete siege and violent airstrikes since months. The delegation visited the schools, institutions, Jafra Center, Palestine Charity, all the government organization inside the camp , UNRWA centers, and the places which were targeted to bombing, where the delegation insured that the camp is empty from weapons or Opposition headquarters.



The initiative was suggested to neutralize the civilians to stop the bombing, and to secure safe roads for entry and exits. It is noted that it is the first time that a responsible man from the regime enters Khan Al Sheih camp after the violent bombing that the camp was exposed to which led to tens of victims and injured amongst the residents of the camp and the displaced families who escaped to the camp from the danger of the



explosive barrels and airstrikes which targeted the surrounding towns and cities. AGPS documented 182 victims from Khan AL Sheih camp since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria.

Jaramana camp residents, which is 8 Km far from Damascus and located on the road to Damascus International Airport, complain of the unavailability of infrastructure such as wastewater services which increased their crises.



They also suffer of the power and water cut all over the camp for long periods daily in addition to the crowdedness of the camp due to the big displacement movement from the Palestinian camps in Damascus, specially Yarmouk, Al Husayneyya and Al Sbeina camps after the war events that affected their camps. The residents of the camp are still suffering from the increased economic crises, which is emphasized in high rents and the high demand on houses that prompted the residents to live under tightened situation in addition to the high rate of unemployment. It comes in a time that UNRWA and Charity originations minimized the aid introduced to the residents but the very little.



In Lebanon, UNRWA filled up the ATM cards of the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon as \$100 rent allowance for each Palestinian of Syria family, and \$27 food allowance for each person as 40 Lebanese Lira. It is mentioned that on July 27 2016, UNRWA carried out census operation to update the data of the displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon.

In Turkey, On August 21, 2016, the organizers, within a sponsorship project for the Palestinian families in southern Turkey, in cooperation with the Islamic Society for the relief of the Orphans and Poor distributed August sponsorships to the Palestinians of Syria families at Kilis city and it is noted that the number of the beneficiaries is 55 Palestinian families. The society, which is originally came from the 48 Palestine and launched in 2016, covered all the Palestinian families available in the southeast and west of Turkey. It is referred that the number of the Palestinians of Syria in turkey according to unofficial statistics reached between 6000 to 8000 refugees distributed between Istanbul and the middle and south governorates in Turkey.

In Norway north of Europe, two Palestinian Syrian refugees in Norway helped injured people after they were exposed to a bus accident with a tractor on one of the roads in Hannevika near Krstian Sand. One of the Norwegian newspaper "Kristian News" wrote about the accident and the two refugees, where Abdul Rahman Thaher, 26 years old, and his friend brought the injured people out of the bus and provided first aid to them despite the injury of one of them. The newspaper described their behaviors as marvelous and they proved to everybody that the bravery

and human qualities of the Arab is still there and they left a beautiful fingerprint for the people.



It is referred that Abdul Rahman Thaher is from Khan Al Sheih camp and he is amongst 79000 Palestinian Syrian refugees who reached Europe till the mid-2016, while thousands of Palestinian Syrian refugees are waiting the chance to reach the European countries.

The AGPS documentation and monitoring team announced that 27 Palestinian died during July 2016, including 9 refugees died due to bombing , 2 refugees died due to torture in the Syrian Prisons, 1 refugee died due to bombardment, 1 refugees died due to sniping, 1 refugee died due to the lack of medical care and siege, and a refugee kidnapped then killed. AGPS referred that the Palestinians victims who died during July are distributed as follows:-

10 died in Damascus Suburb, 6 refugees died in Aleppo, Two refugees died in Damascus, 5 refugees died in separate areas, two refugee died in Sidon south of Lebanon, two refugees died in Der'aa and a refugee in Der'aa.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 22\08\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1162 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1222 days, water was cut for 711 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1014 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1205 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 865 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
