“PLA Victims Toll has risen to 96 Victims”



- A Palestinian girl was killed at Al Wafedein camp.

Victims

Mohammed Mahmoud Saad, a PLA soldier was killed during the clashes that broke out at Tal Kurdi area in Damascus suburb, which raised the PLA victims toll, that was documented by the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, to 96 victims. Most of the PLA victims were killed during clashes broke out in several areas in Damascus suburb, it is mentioned that the military service is compulsory to all Palestinian refugee youth in Syria, as they service in the PLA, which forces many youth, who refuse to attach to the military service during the war, to leave Syria and to travel to the neighboring areas.

Meanwhile, the girl "Nour Ghalib Raslan", 14 years old, was killed due to the bombing that targeted Al Wafedein camp, last Thursday. It is mentioned that Al Wafedein camp is located in the southern entrance of Damascus on the highway between Damascus and Homs and 20 KM far from the capita Damascus.

Recent Updates

The Cypriote Coast Guards rescued, yesterday, a boat that was carrying Palestinian and Syrian Refugees, their boat was launched from the Turkish coasts where it was stuck with one of the big rocks in front of the Cypriote coasts. No news about any injury amongst the refugees.

The water cut from the houses of the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees enters its 75th day respectively in light of the strict siege that is imposed on the remaining residents, where the Regular Army and PFGC checkpoints prevent the entry of food and medical supplies which increased their suffering.

157 victims died due to the shortage of food and medical care. The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of the victims amongst the residents of the Yarmouk camp, since the beginning of the Syrian events, is 988 victims, including 399 due to bombing, 157 due to siege and the lack of medical care, 150 victims due to shooting, 130 victims due to sniping, 96 victims due to torture, 15 victims due to faked execution, 11 victims due to killing after kidnapping, 9 victims due to unknown reason and the Action Group was not able to insure their real death reason, 9 victims due to a bomb car, 6 were assassinated inside the camp, 2 victims due to the building collapsing, one victim due to the crowd while getting the food aids in Rama Square, one due to suffocation, one victim due to burning and a refugee victim due to the white weapon. On the other hand, the surrounding areas of the Khan Danoun camp in Damascus Suburb were exposed to bombing with several shells that were heard clearly inside the camp, which led to a state of tension amongst the residents. In terms of living aspect, the residents complain of the severe shortage in Gas and Diesel and if it was available its price would be high. In the same context, one of the residents insured for our correspondent that they are forced to stay in lines for long hours under the cold in order to get a gas cylinder.

On the other hand, The Palestinians of Syria and Syrian refugees continue their protest in the Greek Athens about the strict security procedures and they were not allowed to leave Greece to other European countries, since Greece is one of the prominent stations that thousands of refugees from Syria pass through to continue their way to Europe but the Greek Authorities increased its strict security procedures towards the refugees passing through its lands which led to hundreds stay of hundreds of them in Greece for several months and wasting what they have of money that they saved for their trip.

In Turkey, The Turkish Relief Society "IHH" in cooperation with the Palestinians of Syria Committee that follows the Turkish Society for the Solidarity with Palestine-FEDAR distributed a number of food baskets on



the displaced Palestinian Syrian families in Ntakeya and Reyhanlı. It is mentioned that hundreds of the Palestinian families were displaced from their camps because of the war going on in Syria.

Missing

The Young man Mohammed Hassan, a PLA officer, was missed several days ago while he was heading to his military car. It is mentioned that he is from Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 22/11/2014

- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 505 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 588 days, water was cut for 75 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.*
- *96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*

- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 407 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 376 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 576 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 222 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
- *Khan Danoun Camp: - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - Power is still cut for more than a year.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.*
