Recent Updates

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented the death of at least 200 Palestinian children as a result of the ongoing war in Syria, pointing out that Statistics will be published within the overall statistical report, which documents the victims of Palestinian Syrian detainees from 2012 to March 2016 at the Group's site in the coming days.

The report includes detailed statistics grouped by date, location, camps, causes of death, in addition to multiple charts.



The report sorts the Palestinian victims who were killed in Syria, according to sex and age, in addition to detailed statistics about the military categorized by militias and factions that are fighting on their side.

On the other hand, a number of Palestinian refugees in southern Syria accused UNRWA in the city of Deraa of helping the Syrian security forces to arrest the Palestinian refugees, especially from the people of Deraa camp and Muzeireeb, after the rejection of UNRWA to delivered the



granted financial aid for some Palestinian refugees and then request them to head to the security branches in Damascus, to be arrested there.

Our correspondent in Daraa confirmed that a large number of Palestinian refugees refused to receive financial and food provided by UNRWA and PLO for fear of being arrested by the Syrian security forces. The Palestine Liberation Organization distributed financial aid last year with the presence of the Syrian security members, and required the presence of the father in order to receive aid, where a large number of refugees were subjected to security check and prosecute, whether they were wanted for the Syrian security or compulsorily recruited into the Palestinian Liberation Army, loyal to the Syrian regime.

People of Daraa and Muzareeb camps are complaining of complete absence of any helps or attempts to stop being targeted by the UNRWA or the PLO, noting that the Syrian regime cut off water from Daraa for 750 Days, and continues bombing Muzareeb compound, leaving victims. The AGPS documented 330 victims of Palestinian refugees in Daraa province who died since the start of war events.

The Syrian Security has released two Palestinian refugee from Al Aedein camp in Homs, they are:

The young man, "Noureddine Qudsi - Abu Mohammed," and the young man, "Ibrahim al-Haj Abdallah - Abu Khalid Al Kahlou," while the security services continue to arrest 186 Palestinians who are still unaccounted for, noting that a number of residents have died due to torture.



The residents of Al Aedein camp in Homs are suffering of significant harassment practices by detachment members of the Syrian security, where they implement occasional arrest, inspection, and audit of the identities of passers-by and the imposing royalties, forcing people to migrate out of the country.

Turning to Sweden, where most of the Palestinian Syrian refugees complain of delays in asylum procedures, where most of them wait for indefinite periods after the Swedish immigration department stopped scheduling interviews for asylum, thus exacerbated the wait state of the refugees for obtaining residence In Sweden.

A number of refugees confirmed to the AGPS that some cases have been waiting for a year and a half, only to obtain residencies, added by between eight months to a year and a half to finish the transaction to reunite the refugee with his family

- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1043 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1104 days, water was cut for 593days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 898days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1091 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 751 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
