Osama Othman Captain of the PLO was killed in Tal Kurdi

- A PLO Captain was killed in Tal Kurdi area in Damascus city.
- Warplanes target the vicinity of Khan AL Sheih Camp with explosive barrels.
- A fire broke out at Ariha School in Khan Dannoun Camp.
- Arresting a woman from the Yarmouk Camp during the aids distribution provided by UNRWA.
- Groups of the opposition arrest a Palestinian affiliated of the Regular Army in Aleppo.

Victims

The refugee "Osama Othman" a Captain of the PLO was killed due to the clashes that broke out Tal Kurdi area in Damascus city, which raises the number of the PLO member victims, since the beginning of the Syrian events and documented by the Action Group, to 88 victims.

Recent Updates

Warplanes hovered above Khan AL Sheih Camp in Damascus city coincided with heavy explosion sounds resulted in the bombing of the adjacent farms and areas with four explosive barrels. It is mentioned that repeated bombing has targeted the camp and the adjacent areas in the past few months and led to the closure of all the roads that link the camp with the city center of Damascus.

On the other hand the Action Group correspondent reported that a fire broke out in Ariha School at Khan Dannoun camp in Damascus city, and according to our correspondent the fire resulted in Short circuit and led to a huge material damages and the burn of some tents was inhabit by refugees inside the school.



The residents of the camp are still live in a state of instability and anticipation for unknown destiny, especially in the past few weeks after the raise of fighting pace in the adjacent villages and areas between the Syrian Opposition forces and the Regular Army. Some of the camps residents from the PFGC and Fatih Movement have participated in the fighting alongside with the Regular Army which made the camp subjected to the bombing and the fall of some shells on different places of it which led to a number of wounded and victims.

According to the statistics of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, the number of the refugees who were killed in Khan Dannoun Camp due to the ongoing events in Syria amounted to 12 people. The barriers of the Regular Army and groups of the PFGC who impose a strict siege on the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus, allows the UNRWA to enter limited quantities of food aids to be distributed on the residents who are waiting to receive this aid since early morning.

Meanwhile, the residents of the camp are complaining of Favoritism and mediations on distributing the food baskets. In the words of one of the people who said: "There are families were given more than one cartons during the past short period while there are other families did not receive any aids for several weeks.



In the same context, according to our correspondent inside the camp, members of the General Command arrested a woman in the camp during the aid distribution without knowing the real reason behind her arrest.

In Al Aedein camp in Homs, a number of PRC Volunteers performed a campaign to raise awareness of personal hygiene in UNRWA schools in the Camp.

Arrest

A group affiliated to the Syrian opposition arrested “Ahmed Waleed Abdul HAq” while he was trying to reach Turkey. It is mentioned that “Abdulhaq” known as “Al Kuki” is a member of the groups that affiliated to the Regular Army.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics:

- The Yarmouk Camp: - The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 475 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 558 days and the water cut for 45 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*
- Al Husayneyya Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 377 days respectively.*
- Al Sbeina Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 346days respectively.*
- Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 546 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*
- Dara'a Camp: - Almost 192 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for the Zakia road.*



- *Khan Danoun Camp: - economic crises continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices.*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - the power is still cut for more than a year, and the road that link the camp with Aleppo is still closed for the sixth days respectively.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.*
