Syria

Presidency of the Syrian Council of Ministers issued a generalization requested all ministries, institutions, companies, and other public entities not to accept the resignation of any Palestinian worker only if he is practicing his work, and that the Palestinian worker, who asks unpaid vacation outside the Syrian Arab Republic, vows not to hire a third party to submit his resignation.



Victims

The Palestinian refugee, Shadi Jaber, died due to the Syrian warplanes shelling that targeted Douma city in Ghoutta-Damascus.



Recent Updates

Several mortar shells targeted Al Wafedeen camp, which is inhabited with a number of Palestinian families, which resulted in a victim and 20 civilian injuries.



The deterioration of the security situation in the adjacent areas and towns to Al Wafwdeen camp, which is located 20 km meters away from the capital Damascus, and the frequent shelling every now and then, had a negative impact on the residents, who already suffer from poverty, high unemployment rate, and poor living conditions even before the events in Syria.

Meanwhile, sources, refused to reveal his identity, close to ISIS inside the besieged Yarmouk camp southern Syria, reported that an Emir of Al Nusra Front known as Abu Ali Saidi, admitted after being arrested by ISIS, that he implemented series of assassinations against prominent figures in the Yarmouk refugee camp, in cooperation with Abu Khader, official of Al Nusra in the camp splitter recently.

The spokesman said about results of the investigation: "The case is still expanding and the assassinations file is revealing day after day, while he considered that the file of Abu Ali Saidi file has become bigger than killing his wife's son Laith Shihabi.

The spokesman added that Abu Khader, the Ansar group leader has the ambition to control the Yarmouk refugee camp, and to turn make it as Ein el-Hilwehcamp, so he had to get rid of several leaders, well-known, and influential figures within the camp, to be able to access the camp - according to the spokesman.

In Aleppo, residents of Nairab camp in Aleppo complain from the continued power outages for more than a month, as a result of the ongoing conflict in the thermal station and Zorba area between the Syrian army and armed opposition groups.



The conflict forced a lot of people to participate private generators for lighting their homes and their shops, which increased their burdens and added new costs that strained families, as well as rising material prices, unemployment, and weak financial resources in light of the war events in the country.

It is worth mentioning that the camp is witnessing a state of instability and unsafely due to the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas, and the involvement of some residents in the fighting alongside the Syrian army which made him vulnerable to shelling which led to a number of victims and injuries.

Lebanon

In cooperation with Al- Shifa'a Commission, Women Committee in the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon held a First Aid training course.



The course continued for two days in which a number of female Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria to Lebanon in Al- Beqaa area



participated in it. The main aim of this course is to benefit from the mechanism of first aid in facing what could happen in the home or the surrounding areas.

The course included lessons about the principles of first aid; choking, and shortness of breath, wounds, and fractures as well as practical lessons about injections and vaccines.

It is noteworthy that the Syrian Palestinian Committee of Syria in Lebanon participated on 17 October, 2017, in a similar course in first aid. At the end of the session, one of the members of the Syrian Palestinian Committee in Lebanon who participated in the session was adopted as a driver for a Al- Shifa'a medical institution's ambulance located in the Barelias emergency point in the east Beqaa.

Violations



Syrian security forces continue detaining three Palestinian brothers and one of their sons; they are: Saif Aldeen Alian Ali, was born in 1969, and was arrested on 7 April 2013 while passing from Husseneia camp checkpoint of the Syrian regime, "Ali Alian Ali" was born in 1987, third



brother "Mohamed Khair Alian Ali" was born in 1972, and his son, "Izz Aldeen Mohammed Khair Ali" was born in 1995.

The three of them were arrested after raiding on their house located in Jarmana city in Damascus suburb on 19 January 2014. It should be noted that Syrian security forces arrest several brothers and Palestinian families including women and children whom their fate is still unknown until the moment.

Numbers and Statistics till 23/11/2015

- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 875 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 945 days, water was cut for 435 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 736 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 937 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 581 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*

- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
