“A Member of Palestine National Liberation Movement- Fatah- was assassinated in Syria at the Yarmouk Camp”



- Clashes and bombing at the Yarmouk camp and more than 20,000 besieged people are deprived of basic services.
- 3 Palestinian victims from Rokn Al Dein compound in Damascus were killed since the beginning of the events in Syria.
- Limited quantities of cooking gas are available at Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb.
- The phenomenon of youth migration from Al Aedein camp in Homs is increasing.
- Water cuts at Daraa camp for 253 days and at the Yarmouk camp for 106 days.
- Egyptian authorities still detain Palestinian Syrian refugees in its prisons.

Victims

The activist Mohammed Qasim Tiraweia, officer of Fatah Movement Region in the Yarmouk camp was killed due to gunshot by unknown person while he was near the 30th street which led to his death, and the identity of the killer, who escaped, is not known yet.

Meanwhile, the PFLP-GC condolences "Mostafa Ahmed Aboud", one of its members, who was killed during the clashes that broke out at the entrance of the Yarmouk camp between the armed groups affiliated to the Syrian opposition and the regular army alongside with the PFGC.

Statistics

The documentation team of the AGPS announced that the number of victims from Rokn Al Dein compound in Damascus suburb, who were killed since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached 3 victims, including 2 were killed due to torture and 1 refugee was killed by a car bomb. It is mentioned that Rokn Al Dein compound inhabitant with hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families.

Recent Updates

Sporadic bombing targeted different places of the Yarmouk camp, coincided with violent clashes between the armed groups affiliated to the



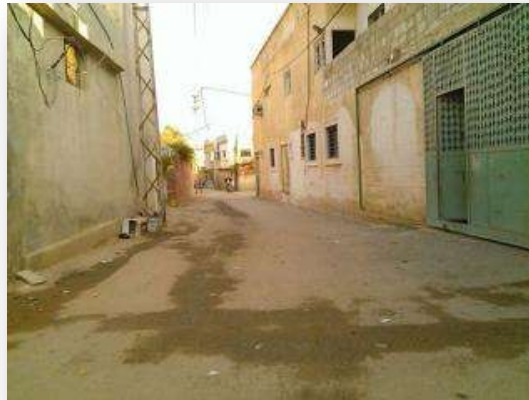
Syrian opposition and the regular army alongside with the PFGC, as the regular army tries to broke into the camp.

The activist Mohammed QasimTiraweia, officer of Fatah Movement Region in the Yarmouk camp was killed due to gunshot by unknown person while he was near the 30th street which led to his death.

Meanwhile, the residents, who are estimated with 20,000 civilians, are still suffering of a severe shortage in medical services due to the strict siege imposed on the camp, in addition to the bombing that targeted the main hospitals of the camp which resulted in severe material damages and led to the stop of those hospitals. Therefore, only Palestine hospital is working in the camp with its minimum capacity due to the medicine and medical cadre shortage because of the siege, in addition to the blackout and unavailability of fuel needed to operate the generators.

In addition to the spread of diseases related to the malnutrition such as Anemia, or kidney diseases related to lack of water, or skin diseases, it is referred that 157 refugees in the camp died as a result of the siege imposed on them because of malnutrition and medical care shortage.

In the same context, and after the severe shortage of cooking gas at Khan AL Sheih camp, limited quantities were entered yesterday, while the price of the gas cylinder has reached 2000 SL, 10 \$. It is referred that the closure of most roads that linking the camp to the neighboring areas is considered the most prominent reasons that led to the shortage of many main supplies.

And at Al Aedein camp in Homs, since the youth started to migrate and resort to Turkey for fear of being arrest by the Syrian security forces, while in the second half of 2014 a large number of youth were arrested, forcing them to flee of the camp and move to other areas or resort to Turkey then to Europe.



Death boats

On the other hand, and despite the relative calm in the Palestinian camps, which are under the Syrian regime's control such as (Neirab, Khan Dannon, Al Raml in Latakia, Al Aedein in Homs, Al Aedein in Hama, and Jermana) However, these camps are suffering from the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas, which made the camp subjected to bombardment and shells, resulted in a number of victims, they also complain about the deplorable living conditions as a result of the continuation of the conflict in Syria.

In the meantime, the water cuts in Daraa camp for Palestinian refugees southern of Syria for 253 days, while the Yarmouk refugee camp still suffering from the continued water cuts for 106 days respectively, amid the aggravated humanitarian suffering, while the two camp are suffering of power cut and severe shortage of medical services.



Egypt

The Egyptian authorities are still detain 56 Palestinian refugees from Syria after arresting them while they were trying to reach Italy launching from the Turkish shores on 25th of the last month, since they were victims of a scam by smugglers who left them in front of an Egyptian island where they were arrested there.

It is mentioned that the Egyptian security released all Syrian detainees while still detain 56 Palestinians after all surrounding countries refused to receive them, as they were told to choose to be deported to Syria or stay in prison.

The detainees renewed their appeal to all international and human rights organizations to urgently and immediately intervene to release them and alleviate their suffering.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 23/12/2014

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2586 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS including 157 women, 279 were killed due to torture, 268 were killed by sniper shot, 84 refugees were field executed, and 984 refugees were killed due to bombing.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 536 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 617 days, water was cut for 106 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November 2014.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 438 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 408 days respectively.*

- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for **609** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost **253** days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- **Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al AedeinCamps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
