Statistic

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of Palestinian Syrian victims who were killed at Al Nairab camp in Aleppo since the beginning of the Syrian events till August 2014 is 56 victims according to the statistics documented by the documentary team of the Group.

It is referred that on 11-7-2012, AL Nairab camp has lost 11 young men who were targeted by unknown armed group during their return from Mesiaf area, as they were performing their military service in the PLA.

Italy

A group of Syrian and Palestinian Syrian refugees launched an appeal to the Red Crescent and human rights organizations to intervene for their release after the Italian coastguards detained them in a prison at Squilih. The Italian coastguards arrested the refugees after they reached the Italian beaches by the boat that left the Libyan city of Zouara on 18-9-2014.

In the same context, the Italian Navy announced that they rescued more than 750 migrants in three rescue operations during the past days; the refugees included Syrians and Palestinian Syrians.

Mahmoud Saleem Rafe' from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo and Firas Ahmed Mer'I from Jermana in Damascus city were killed due to the clashes between the Syrian Opposition and the Regular Army that is supported with the PLA.

Recent Updates

A state of worry prevailed Yarmouk camp due to the snipping of the main road and targeting a number of civilians with the snipers shot without any injuries. Our correspondent from inside the camp stated that unknown group planted an explosive bomb near AL Talaea garden followed by a powerful explosion sound and exchange fire, with no details due to the security situation deterioration.

In terms of living aspect, the suffering of residents of the Yarmouk camp is still Aggravating due to the suspension of the distribution of food aid provided to them by the UNRWA and the continued cut of drinking water for the fifth day respectively.

The water crises prompted a number of committees and institutions working on the campground to resort to digging artesian wells to provide water to the camp's residents who complain about the continuation of the siege imposed on the camp for nearly fourteen months respectively, which led to a lack of necessities of life, and break all the basic services such as



electricity, cellular phone and Internet service, add this to the lack of fuel and cooking gas.

In a related context, warplanes hovered in the skies of Khan Al Sheih Camp in Damascus city yesterday, coincided with voices of violent explosions caused by the bombing of the surrounding areas, while our correspondent stated news about the injury of a young man in the camp by a sniper shot on Zakya _ Khan Al Sheih road.

In terms of economic aspect, the camp's residents are suffering from many crises, including the acute shortage of medical supplies and food because of frequent cut for the roads that connect the camp with the city of Damascus, in addition to the continued power, communications network and the Internet cut for long periods. Meanwhile, the residents of Al Neirab camp in Aleppo northern Syria, suffering of high prices, widespread of unemployment, lack of many basic materials, and the continued cut of Internet, telecommunications and electricity several months ago.

On the other hand, people of AL Aedein camp in Homs complain of miserable economic conditions due to the reflection of the manifestations of the conflict in Syria, where they suffered from the continued cut of landlines, Internet service and power supply for long periods, scarcity of food and fuel and the difficulty of obtaining bread, in addition to the strict security procedures towards them, prompting a number of families and youth to leave the camp.

People of Al Husseneia camp are still waiting to return to their camp, where residents displaced due to violent clashes between the regular army and groups of the FSA, which ended with the control of the regular army at the camp about several months ago.

The rest of Daraa camps' residents appealed to the Authority, the Palestinian factions, the human rights organizations and UNRWA to look at their humanity and living situations and intervene to neutralize the camp from the conflict in Syria and make it a safe area, as the humanitarian disaster befall of the camp because of the continuing daily shelling and clashes inside alleys and streets. In addition to the siege imposed by the regular army, which led to the depletion of most of the basic materials such as bread, flour, fuel and medicines. On the other hand, people of the camp complain about the continuing power and



communication cut for most regions before weeks ago and several months.

Release

The Syrian Security released the relief activist Taha Al Abed from Al Aedin camp in Homs on 21/9/2014 after being arrested for about a week, Taha is 30 years old and he is from Al Nasira city in Palestine.

Missing

The Palestinian Syrian refugee Haweyya Saeed Anbatawi was missed in 6/9/2014 while she was leaving through Alexandria beach to Italy and there is no information about her till now.
