### *Recent Updates*

*A number of medical staff and residents of Yarmouk appealed all stakeholders, UNRW, and the Red Crescent for the introduction of typhoid fever and jaundice medications to the camp, due to run out of medicine that has been entered on 4 September by the Negotiating Committee, and the continuing spread of diseases among residents.*

*Meanwhile, they warned of the consequences of slowdown in entering the necessary medicine and drugs for fear of being spread among residents of the besieged camp.*



*Clashes broke out between the Syrian army and Al-Nusra Front on the first axis of Yarmouk, as clashes were heard at ALthalathein Street between Al-Nusra alongside ISIS and armed opposition groups after the killing of a leader of Nusraat Alqadam area.*

*The clashes coincided with the continuous control imposed by ISIS and Al-nusra over the Yarmouk camp, and the strict siege imposed on the camp for 813 days by the regular army and PFGC groups, as well as the prevention of entering urgent relief and medical assistance to the camp.*



*On the other hand, the remaining residents of Daraa camp are suffering of acute crises in basic services because of the great destruction of the camp after repeated shelling, which led to extensive damage to the infrastructure. It is referred that most families of the camp, who are nearly 4,000 families, were forced to flee the camp because of the poor conditions, while only about 100 families remained and suffer from difficult living conditions where basic services are almost non-existent, especially with regard to health services, electricity, and drinking water.*



*The displaced Palestinian Syrian refugees who left their camps suffer from economic crises such as the rising houses rents in the areas they resorted to, the average of houses rents is from \$150 to \$350. The high prices came in light of the widespread unemployment, where most of the refugees lost their work and jobs due to war in Syria. It is referred that Al Zahera, Jaramana, AL Maydan, Qudseya town, and Khan Al Sheih are the most areas that receive displaced refugees from their camps.*



### ***Palestinian Liberation Army***

*Chief of the PLA, Major General Mohammed Tariq Khadraa, announced that the PLA is fighting in more than 15 locations in Daraa suburb, Sweida and Damascus, including Zabadani, Adra, Maliha, Jobar, Moadamieh, Darya, and Tel Kurd.*



*He revealed in a statement to Al-Watan newspaper affiliated to the Syrian regime "that, several months after the events in a number of Syrian cities and towns in 2011, he suggested to the Syrian leadership that the PLA should participate with the Syrian army in confronting terrorism," where the Syrian leadership decided that the Liberation Army is to protect the important national installations in the vicinity of Damascus.*

*He also added that; "We secured thermal plant in Harran Awameed, Deir Ali, industrial area of Adra city, and the Free Zone and fuel warehouses, adding that with the increasing attacks on the headquarters of the army and his staff and military installations that were under the protection of the army, we were forced to transfer the headquarters to other places, and the PLA operations were expanded by participating in offensive operations on the fronts."*

*Mr. Khadraa speech came after a number of activists and families of victims and recruits appeals for the Chief of the PLA, the PLO, and*



*stakeholders not pushing their children in conflict in Syria, and not to send them to areas of tension, and to stop the shedding of the blood of Palestinian youth in the battle, noting that the Palestinian refugees in Syria are obligated to military service in the Palestinian Liberation Army. Anyone who refused to join will be vulnerable to prosecution and imprisonment, while many members and officers were split of the army and joined the opposition groups to fight against the Syian regime.*

*It is mentioned that the AGPS documented 149 PLA victims were killed during clashes with armed opposition groups in several parts of Syria since the start of the war events.*

### **Malaysia**

*For the ninth day respectively, the Palestinian refugee Ibrahim Abu Kharj continues hunger strike protesting on his detention by the Malaysian authorities for the 12 consecutive days in Kuala Lumpur airport, moreover, they banned him to enter Malaysia after he left it trying to reach Europe before he has been arrested by the Cambodian police and returned back to Malaysia.*





### **Lebanon**

*In the occasion of Eid Al Adha Al Mubarak, The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon contributed to distribute 300 food parcels, last Friday. The food parcels are presented from Zamzam Association and Al Quds Charity Committee for the Displaced Palestinian Syrian Families at Al Beddawi camp in Tripoli north of Lebanon. It is worthy to mention that the number of the Palestinian Syrian families at Al Beddawi camp is 850 families from 45000 Syrian Palestinian Refugees who escaped the ongoing war in Syria to Lebanon.*

### **Turkey**

*The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributed Eid clothes presented from Al Sarra Organization to the displaced Palestinian Syrian children in Turkey in order to draw the happiness on their faces especially during Eid Al Adha Al Mubarak to alleviate their suffering and pain. It is referred that the distribution process included Antakya, Reyhanlı, İskenderun, and Kirikhan in Turkey.*





***Numbers and Statistics till 23/9/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 813 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 883 days, water was cut for 373 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 675 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 875 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 520 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
